 - It was noted that the township is willing to work with the cities to help them grow in the future.
 - O John Holden noted the feedback that we have received from the township residents during the past public meetings.
- City of Northfield
 - Mayor Rhonda Pownell open the meeting for questions.
 - Ben Martig asked for clarification on where the industrial area would be and when Comus junction is located.

 - Questioned where the land is that we think they can build on?

 - What is meant by services to the township?
 - Response by the Supervisors included: Roads, Flood Mitigation, Storm
 Damage clean up, and Planning and Zoning.

 - In the Commercial area would you need to hook up to Northfield or Faribault for sewer services?
 - Glen Switzer
 - Is there concern regarding Faribault taking over the township?
 - Mayor Rhonda Pownell
 - It would be nice to see Rice County's land use changes.

- Glen Switzer
 - Industrial areas should be kept in the cities. The new auto club will include 300 full time houses. So, Rice County will allow anything.
- John McCarthy
 - The Dundas city engineer worked with the Wolf Creek developer and found that the package septic system would not work for them.
- Larry Fowler
 - In anticipation, we built up infrastructure for expansion at great expense would you be willing reimburse the City of Dundas?
- Ben Martig
 - Do you anticipate any changes to the current timeline?
- Mayor Rhonda Pownell
 - The Northfield City Council does not have a position on this topic. We will need
 additional information to determine if the incorporation is consistent with the cities
 long term values.
 - The City would like to explore a new annexation agreement.
 - The City is still working with Waterford to reach a new agreement.
 - Future meetings will be arranged.
- Glen Switzer
 - Trust has been eroded, he does not trust the township.
 - The City and Board have not been meeting. The City has asked many times for a
 meeting but it has not happened. Nothing regarding this was brought up at the
 PCARD meeting.
