- ❖ John Klockeman called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm.
- Members present were John Klockeman, Frances Boehning, Bruce Morlan, Larry Alderks, and Jeff Johnson. Staff present was Cindy Nash. Ex-officio Supervisor Mike Little
- Guests: Supervisor Kathleen Kopseng, Supervisor Glen Castore.
- Bruce Morlan made a motion to approve the agenda, Jeff Johnson seconded, motion approved.
- ❖ Jeff Johnson made a motion to approve the minutes of December 9, 2021, Bruce Morlan seconded, motion approved.
- ❖ The Open Forum was opened and closed at 7:04 pm. No comments.
- Public Hearing:
 - o Flood Plain Ordinance
 - Cindy Nash reviewed the purpose of updating the Flood Plain Ordinance.
 - Public Hearing was opened at 7:06 pm
 - No comments were made.
 - The Public Hearing was closed at 7:06 pm.
 - Jeff Johnson made a motion to approve the Flood Plain Ordinance, Frances Boehning seconded, all approved.
 - Cindy Nash reviewed in general how properties are affected by the flood plain map changes.
 - A short discussion was held regarding the language used in the ordinance and government flood plain information.

New Business

- o Rural Industrial Zone Ordinance.
 - The current Rice Cty table was reviewed.
 - The following were changed from C.U.P to I.U.P; Archery range –
 outdoor, Temporary asphalt plant or highway construction yard, Home
 occupation conditional, Seasonal roadside stand, and Temporary farm
 dwelling. The following were changed to not permitted; Temporary
 meteorological test towers and Outdoor storage. Solar energy
 production was changed to roof mounted only.
 - RI district redline
 - A discussion was held regarding the wording of the redline standards.
 - The definition of "front yard" needs to be clarified.
 - Under development standards, it was noted that "Kynar" is a brand name and should be replaced with a generic term.
 - Larry Alderks asked how the standards for roads will be established.
 - o Cindy Nash reviewed how roads are typically developed.
 - The Commissioners expressed concern that driveways will be placed every 200 feet and properties in the back will become landlocked.

- A request was made to determine how to design roads and public areas.
- The Commissioners discussed the potential difficulties with accessing the southern part of the rural industrial area.
 - A request was made to look into the possibility of a road access between the Heselton and DeGroot properties.
- The requested changes will be made and returned to the Planning Commission in March. A public hearing will be scheduled for April.
- o Comp Plan
 - The draft of the Bridgewater Comp Plan was provided to the Planning Commissioners. A request was made to submit suggested changes to Glen Castore.
