- Old Business:
  - o Comprehensive Plan Discussion
    - Carolyn Braun reviewed the focus of the comp plan.
    - Larry Alderks if climate preservation would be addressed in the plan.
    - John Klockeman reviewed the main topics to be discussed during the meeting.

- o Discussion on Northfield Climate Action Plan
  - Bruce Morlan reviewed the new Northfield Climate Action Plan
    - A short discussion was held regarding the impact of this on the township.

## Miscellaneous:

- Bike Trail
  - Reviewed the funds to purchase additional land for a bike trail.
- Wolf Creek Auto
  - A discussion was held regarding how public comments are handled.
- Solar Garden
  - Discussed how the current C.U.P conditions and standards are created and enforced.
- o Xcel Energy altering the "value of Solar" rate.
  - Staff will look into ramifications of this rate change on the township.
- Affordable housing
  - A short discussion was held regarding the current state of affordable housing.
- Compliance updates
  - A request was made to have Jim Braun check on Jesse Jacobson's property.
  - An update was given on the status of the house on 1<sup>st</sup> Timberlane. The house will be secured by early December.
  - The house on Armstrong road will be referred to legal action.
