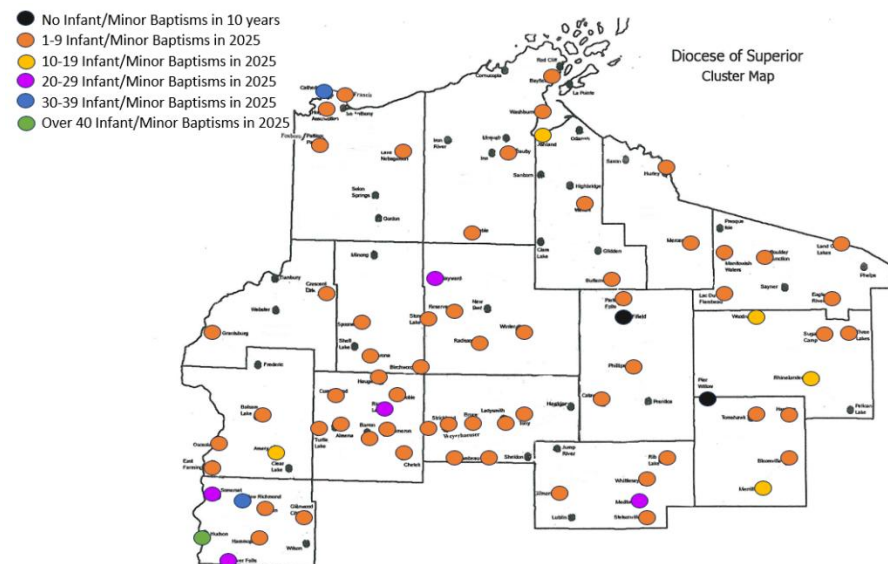
2025 SACRAMENTS (+FUNERALS)

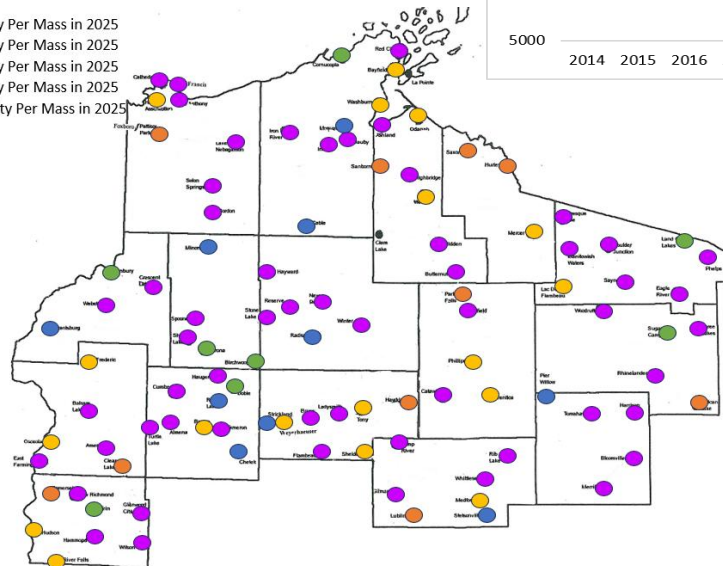

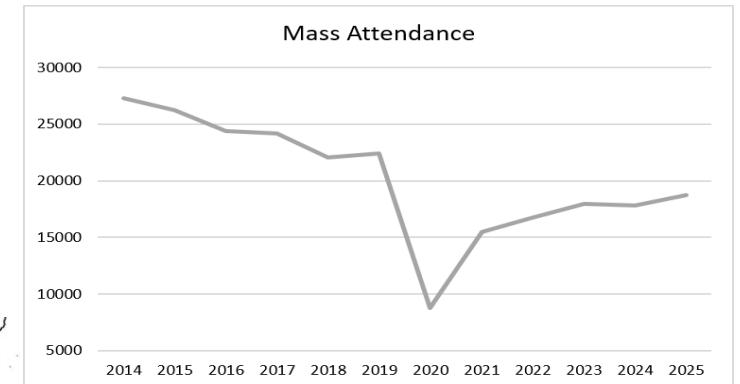

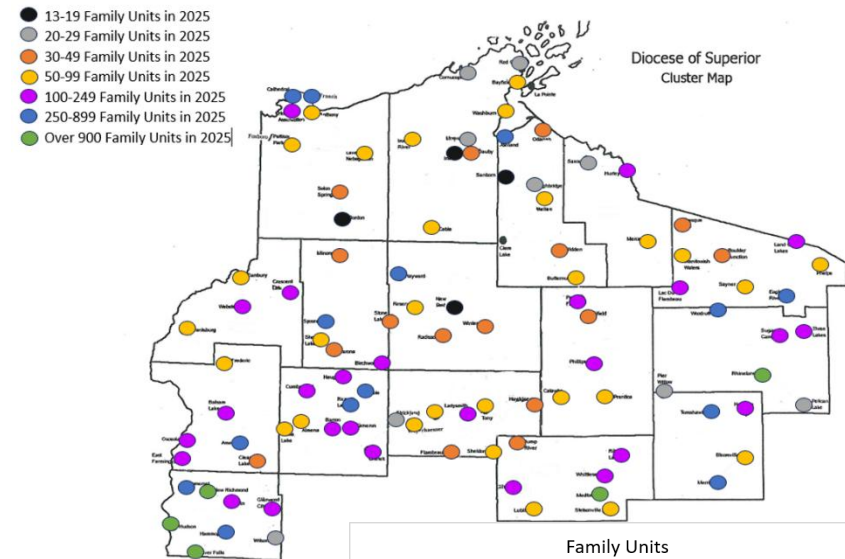

2025 POPULATION

2 parish communities have lost around 50% of their population in the past 25 years.

(Weyerhaeuser (-58.2%) and Pier Willow (-47.1%))

18 parish communities have lost between 10-28% of their population in the past 25 years.

4 communities have gained more than 40% of population in the past 25 years.

(New Richmond (+40.7%), Hudson (41.2%), Cornucopia (42.5%), Somerset (54.1%))

19 parish communities have gained 10-20% in population in the past 25 years.

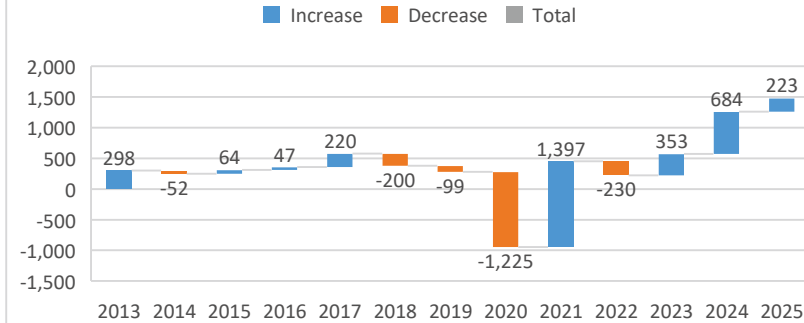

Plate Collection Increase or Decrease Year over Year

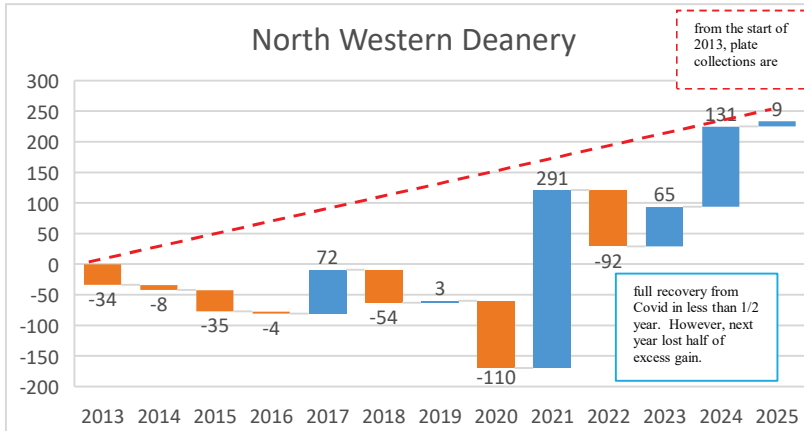

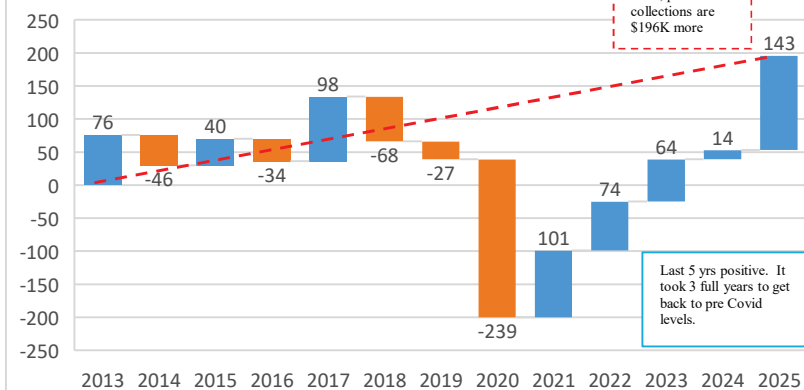


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South Central Deanery

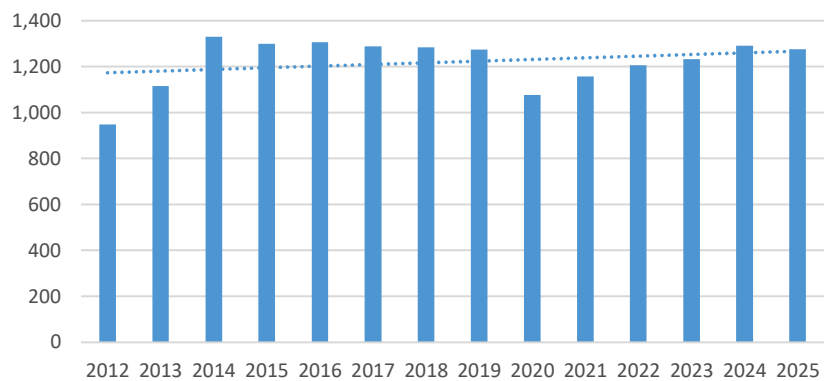

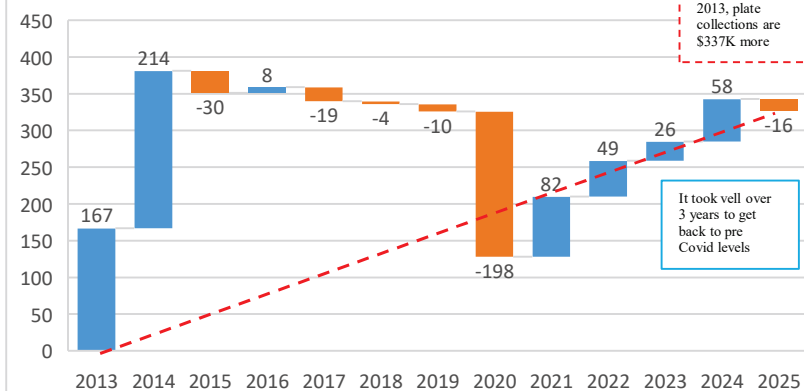

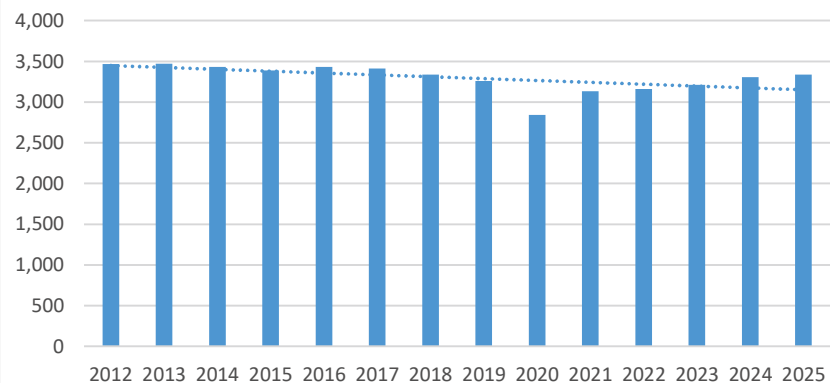
