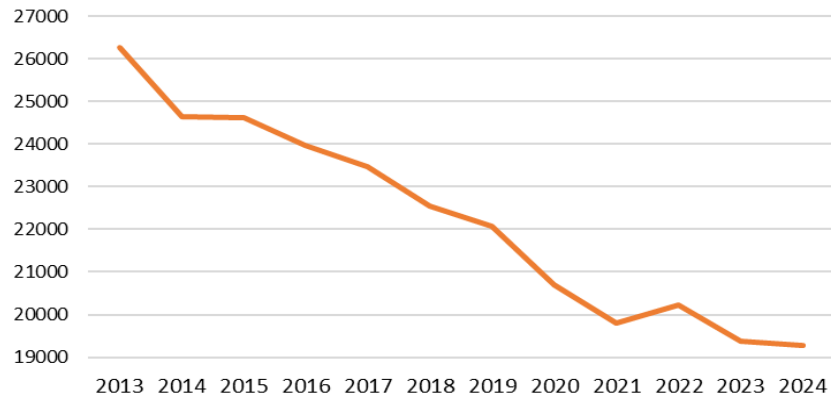

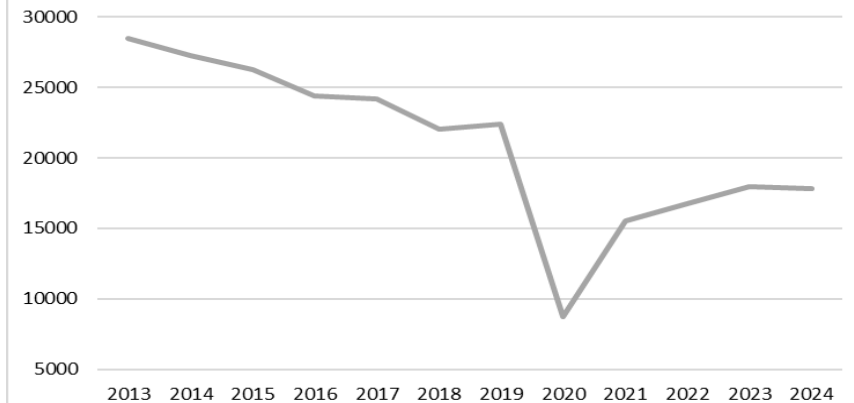

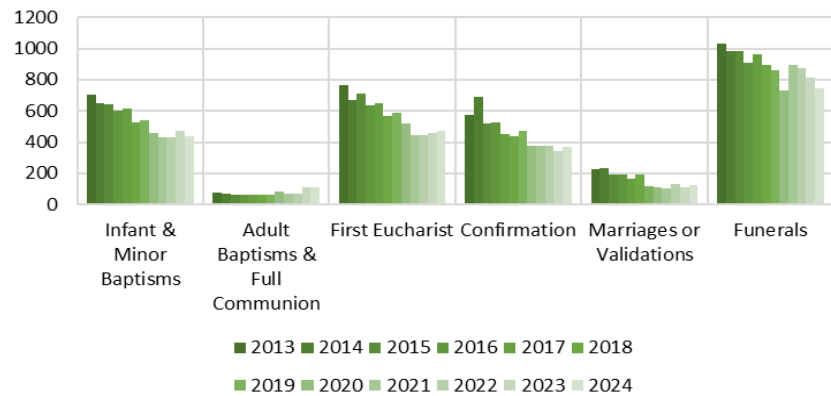

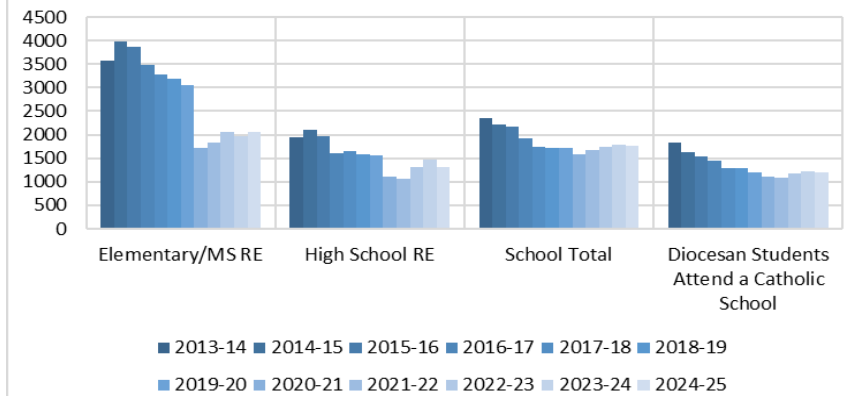

2024 YOUTH STATS

- 2,292 Elementary and Middle School Children in Religious Education Programs
- 1,229 High School Youth in Religious Education Programs
- 3,639 Total Religious Education Children/Youth
 - -2,887 in past 10 years
 - +266 since 2020
- 1,933 Total School* Children
- 1,241 Catholic Children in Schools*
 - -423 in past 10 years
 - +134 since 2020
- 4,884 Total Parish Youth in Religious Education or Schools*

- 3 parishes with over 300 children/youth, no programs over 400 – Hudson*, River Falls*, Medford*
- 3 parishes with 200-300 children/youth – Superior Cathedral*, Somerset*, New Richmond*
- 8 parishes with 100-200 children/youth – Rhinelander*, Hammond, Ashland*, Merrill*, Dobie*, Rice Lake*, Woodruff*, Moquah*
- 25 parishes with less than 10 children/youth
- 17 parishes with no children/youth
- 5 parishes with no children/youth programs since before 2014 – Cornucopia, Gordon, Pier Willow, Stone Lake, Wilson

2024 INFANT & MINOR BAPTISMS

- 431 Baptisms
 - -5,237 in past 10 years
 - -1,343 since 2020
- 1 parish with more than 40 – Hudson
- 0 parishes with 31-40
- 3 parishes with 21-30 – Superior Cathedral, New Richmond, Somerset, River Falls
- 9 Parishes with 10-20 – Medford, Rice Lake, Woodruff, Ashland, Merrill, Hayward, Ladysmith, Cameron, Spooner
- 36 parishes with no baptisms

2024 MASS ATTENDANCE

- 147.5 Mass per Weekend
 - 18,140 Average Attendance
 - 19,365 in July
 - 16,052 in October
 - 16 parishes nearly double or triple attendance in July (40% or more) compared to October (Superior Assumption, Lake Nebagamon, Gordon, Chetek, Rib Lake, Cable, Sanborn, Cornucopia, Lac du Flambeau, Sugar Camp, Land O'Lakes, Sayner, Boulder Junction, Presque Isle, Pelican Lake, Woodruff)

- 13 parishes have larger attendance in October (15% or more) compared to July (Barron, Erin Prairie, Wilson, Weyerhaeuser, Lublin, Catawba, Reserve, Tony, Fifield, Jump River, Ashland, Bayfield, Highbridge)
- 29,840 Church Capacities
- 35% of cumulative Church capacity filled on average
- 22 Churches more than 50% Full on average per Mass
- 13 Churches less than 20% Full on average per Mass
- 159 Weekday Masses
 - 14 Churches with no weekday Mass
 - 1,617 Average Weekday Mass Attendance

2024 FAMILY UNITS

- 20,163 Family Units
- 54,443 Registered Parishioners
- 15,946 Envelope Holders
- 29% of Registered Parishioners are Envelope Holders
- 38.57% of Registered Parishioners are over 65 years old
- 31.16% of Registered Parishioners are 25-64 years old
- 16.54% of Registered Parishioners are under 24 years old
- 25.89% are Unknown
- 15.12% of Registered Parishioners are Native American
- 2.47% of Registered Parishioners are Hispanic
