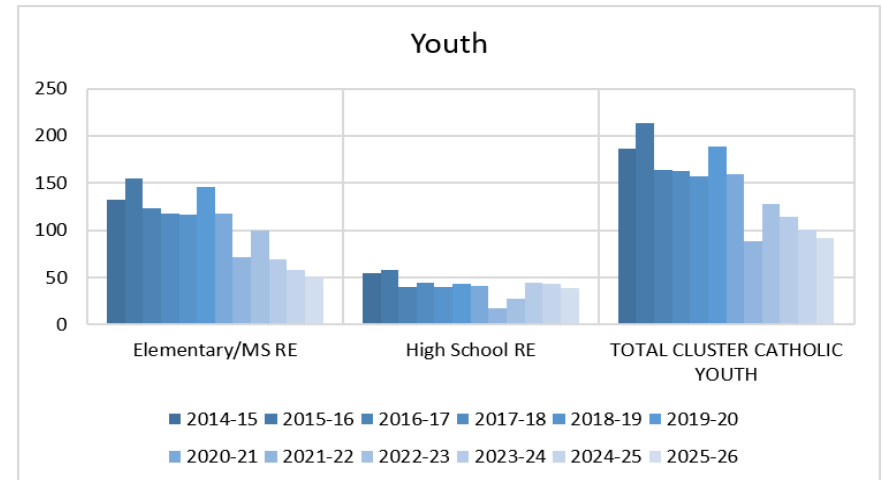
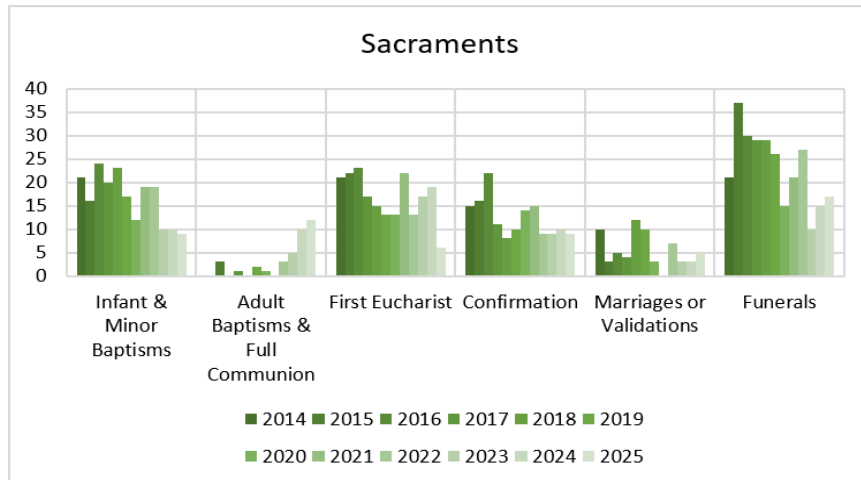

3.05 is the Wisconsin statistic for average individuals in a family unit. The grey line, in the Mass Offerings chart shows Number of Masses per Attendance Needed indicates the number of Masses the parish would need to offer in order for a vibrant and reverent, full Mass to take place, based on the average number of individuals who attend. Percentage of Family Units Attending Mass (yellow line) on Mass Attendance chart is calculated to the right of the line graph. This shows how many family units, based on Mass attendance, actually attend Mass regularly. Mass Attendance is the average Mass attendance recorded in July and October of the year.



The Youth chart only shows the number of children in religious education at the parish and the number of children from this parish who are registered at a Catholic school in the Diocese of Superior.
