#### Catechism Corner Answers

- 1. *B) Eucharist-*-The Eucharist is called the 'source and summit of the Christian life' (CCC 1324). All the other sacraments are oriented towards it
- 2. *B) Universal--*The word Catholic comes from the Greek 'katholikos' meaning 'universal' or 'according to the whole'
- 3. *D) Charitable--*The four marks of the Church are One, Holy, Catholic, and Apostolic. Charitable it not one of them, though the Church is called to practice charity
- 4. *C) A re-presentation (making present) of Christ's one sacrifice.* The Church teaches, and Aquinas clarifies that the Mass is not a new or repeated sacrifice but a re-presentation of the once-for-all sacrifice of Christ at Calvary (CCC 1366-1367)
- 5. *B) Principle of Double Effect*--The Principle of Double Effect states that an action with both good and bad effects can be morally permissible if the act itself is good or neutral, the good effect is intended, and the good outweighs the unintended evil effect.
- 6. *B) St. Augustine of Hippo-*-St. Augustine argued against the Donatists that the validity of sacramnts depends not on the holiness of the minister but on the power of Christ who works through the sacraments (ex opere operato)
