**John Knox Presbytery
Annual Report of Teaching Elder Member at-Large**

The John Knox Presbytery through the Committee on Ministry requires annual reports from ministers of the Word and Sacrament to determine that they are fulfilling the criteria for membership¹ *b. Member-at-large*

A member-at-large is a minister of the Word and Sacrament who has previously been engaged in a validated ministry, and who now, without intentional abandonment of the exercise of ministry, is no longer engaged in a ministry that complies with all the criteria in G-2.0503a. A minister of the Word and Sacrament may be designated a member-at-large because he or she is limited in his or her ability to engage in a ministry fulfilling all of the criteria for a validated ministry due to family responsibilities or other individual circumstances recognized by the presbytery. A member-at-large shall comply with as many of the criteria in G-2.0503a as possible and shall actively participate in the life of a congregation. A member-at-large is entitled to take part in the meetings of the presbytery and to speak, vote, and hold office. The status of member-at large shall be reviewed annually. G-2.0503a
