

LENTEN STATIONS OF THE CROSS AND CONFESSIONS

<u>STATIONS:</u> Join us on Wednesdays at 6:00pm during Lent for Stations of the Cross. Soup will be served from 5:15-5:45pm by the Activities Committee. The dates for Stations are: March 22, 29 and will conclude on April 5.

<u>CONFESSIONS:</u> During the Stations of the Cross, confessions will be heard from 6:00-6:45pm.

LENTEN GUIDELINES

FASTING is observed by all 18 years of age or older, who have not yet celebrated their 59th birthday. On a fast day, one full meal is allowed. Two other meals sufficient to maintain strength may be taken according to each ones needs, but together they should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted, but liquids, including milk and juices are allowed.

ABSTINENCE is observed by all 14 years of age and older on Good Friday and Friday's during Lent. On days of abstinence, no meat is allowed. Note that when health or ability to work would be seriously affected, the law does not oblige. When in doubt concerning fasting and abstinence, the parish priest should be consulted.

FASTING, **ALMSGIVING** AND **PRAYER** are three traditional disciplines of Lent. The faithful should undertake these practice seriously in a spirit of penance and the renewal of baptism at Easter.








OUR LADY'S MEMORIALS


