KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS



REFLECTION ON GOD AND SERVICE

When my dad signed us up for a service trip in Knoxville, Tennessee, I had no idea the impact that week would have on my life. Catholic Heart Work Camp is a camp dedicated to serving its communities and helping all campers grow closer to God. The daily routine looked like this: Wake up at 6:30am, eat breakfast, go to Mass, go to your worksite till about 3:30pm, shower, eat dinner and then go to the program they would host every night. Programs varied from stories, signaling, skits, and even competitions. I won the "Longest Amen Contest" and set a new camp record of 35 seconds! At the beginning of the week, everyone was split into groups of 8-10 people. The resident my workgroup was serving was a 70-year-old woman named Belinda. Belinda, who lives in a trailer infested with mold, is also raising her 13-year-old Autistic grandson, Dalton. Life is not easy for the two, but you would never know it by judging based on their spirit. Seeing the way they lived truly humbled me. My group was building stairs in the back and the front side of the trailer. The previous stairs were cinder blocks. I must admit, I did not do nearly as much work as my teammates. Dalton took a real liking to me. Instead of building stairs, I played Dinosaurs, read, and watched YouTube with Dalton almost the entire time. I've got a friend for life. Just witnessing Dalton and his grandmother's lifestyle gave me so much gratitude for my own life, I left Tennessee with a whole new outlook on living.

Even if you take away what I learned from Dalton and Belinda, it was still one of, if not the best week of my life. Going to Mass, saying the Rosary, and being around strong-hearted Catholic people every day, who love God, made an enormous impact on my faith. Before I went on the service trip, I would have considered myself a lazy Catholic. Sure, sometimes I read at Mass and I'd go to church almost every Sunday, but Monday-Saturday, I was not thinking about God. Since returning from Tennessee, I have never felt closer to God. I've felt him and his love consume me. Since I returned home, I've been going to daily Mass, I've been saying the rosary daily, if not multiple times a day, and I've been praying in my free time. I have never felt such peace and joy in my life; I have never been this happy. The moment that I realized God loved me more than I could have ever imagined was during an Adoration at CHWC. The entire camp proceeded from the auditorium where the nightly program was held to the church. Everyone sang together as we made the walk over through the courtyard. After walking into the church, I sat down in a random pew with my dad. As a few people left their seats and went up to the altar to pray on their knees, I got the urge to do so as well. Within seconds of kneeling down, being face to face with Jesus, and hearing the beautiful, out-of-this-world harmonious voices of the Antonyraj twins, I burst out into tears, happy tears. I had never felt God's presence so strongly. I could feel his everlasting love for me and I knew in that moment everything was going to be okay. I realized God was always going to be there for me. Additionally, not only did I feel God's presence, but I also felt my mother's, who passed away last July after a 14-year-long battle with Breast Cancer. My favorite part and realization of the entire trip was that Adoration felt like it was a once in a lifetime experience, but after talking to Father Campo, I now know that that was just the beginning of my journey with God.


