MISSION TRIP REFLECTION

My name is Trinity Bresciani. I joined the mission trip to Knoxville, Tennessee, but wasn't sure what to expect. I had a few ideas, but it was so much more. From the very beginning, everyone I met was so welcoming and friendly. On this trip, everyone was put in uncomfortable circumstances. But these circumstances helped me appreciate all the little things we have that we take for granted in our everyday lives.

My work job during the week was working with the homeless at shelters and food pantries. Being able to interact with homeless, or very needy people and talk to them was such an amazing opportunity. One of my jobs at the pantry was to give people a choice of one bag of fruit or one bag of vegetables. Some of these people had multiple kids and only had the choice of one thing to feed their entire family, and the kids didn't understand why they couldn't have just a few strawberries or one more bag of chips. Another situation was a woman who came in for some new clothes because she didn't have many and she just got a job. I was looking for some pants for her and she said none of them would fit and asked if we had any kid's sizes because she has cancer and keeps losing weight. Eventually, we found something that fit her in the kid's section, so she asked if there was a backpack or purse to carry the clothes in. I couldn't find any bag so she started to leave and as she was walking out, a piece of leather caught my eye, so I grabbed it. It was a beat up purse. I gave it to her, and even though it was a purse that most people would throw away because it was so damaged, she was so happy that she had something to carry clothing in and maybe even a little bit of food. What stood out to me the most during these days was the fact that these were some of the happiest people and yet they have almost nothing.

At the end of each day, we would have some activities or free time, but one of my favorite things was being able to pray the Liturgy of the Hours with our group every morning and night. Oftentimes we would drop what we were doing and go to the chapel to pray together. It was moving how open everyone was to spending time with God, and the Liturgy of the Hours is something that I am trying to continue in my life now.

I think praying like this and working with the poor showed me that we don't have to do extraordinary things to do God's will, sometimes the smallest things can make the biggest changes, whether it be smiling at a stranger or talking to someone that is alone. We never know what people are going through and you might be the only person they talk to that day. By loving people like Jesus tells us to, we can truly live up the CHWC slogan "made for more", because we were made for more than just existing; we were made to help each other and pick each other up on our path to heaven.

This entire trip helped me grow in my relationship with God in many ways and I hope I will be able to go again. I strongly believe everyone, whether young or old, should experience a CHWC at some point in their life!
