NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
Community Development Block Grant Application

The City of Hornell, New York has scheduled a public hearing for Monday, July 21, 2025. The hearing will start at 6:45 PM and will be conducted at Hornell City Hall, located at 82 Main Street, Hornell, NY 14843.

The public hearing will be held to discuss community development needs and priorities, and to provide residents with information about the 2025 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program and other funding opportunities available through the Consolidated Funding Application (CFA). The CDBG program is administered by the New York State Office of Community Renewal (OCR) and will make available, to eligible local governments, approximately \$40 million for the 2025 program year to support housing, economic development, public facilities, public infrastructure, and planning activities, with the principal purpose of benefiting low- to moderate-income households. The City of Hornell is currently proposing to apply for up to \$2 million in CDBG funding to make Phase 1C improvements to the City's Water Pollution Control Plant.

The hearing will provide further information about the CDBG program and will allow for citizen participation in the development of any proposed grant applications and/or to provide technical assistance to develop alternate proposals. Comments on the CDBG program or proposed project(s) will be received during the hearing. The hearing is being conducted pursuant to Section 570.486, subpart I of the CFR, and in compliance with the requirements of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended.

Hornell City Hall is in compliance with accessibility standards under the Americans with Disabilities Act.
