WHEREAS, §168-5 establishes property maintenance requirements regarding exterior standards for the City of Hornell and states that "all buildings shall reflect a level of maintenance in keeping with the standards of the community and shall not constitute blight from the point of view of adjoining property owners or lead to the progressive deterioration of the neighborhood."; and

WHEREAS, the Common Council for the City of Hornell strongly believes that a lack of property maintenance and blight can negatively impact the quality of life for residents for the City of Hornell; and

WHEREAS, the property located at 33 East Washington Street in the City of Hornell has been ticketed at least eight times for failing to meet exterior standards and poor property maintenance, and is currently in court proceedings regarding the blight and general nuisance concerns at the location; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Common Council of the City of Hornell calls on the Hornell City Court to take decisive and meaningful action in the current legal proceedings related to 33 East Washington Street.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Common Council of the City of Hornell strongly urges the Hornell City Court to take any and all actions necessary to abate the nuisance and negative impact of this property on the surrounding neighborhood and the City of Hornell.
