MISCELLANEOUS:

Mayor Buckley asked Rich Dunning how things were going at the Water Pollution Control Plant. Rich said the good news is that the UV system is almost ready to go. Rich also mentioned that they have to send samples of Effluent to the DEC if they come back below 20 parts per million, they can continue to sludge if it comes back above 50 parts per million, they would need to use a sludge press. Sludge presses squeezes it to a 20% solid which is what is needed to go into the land fill. When they had to use the sludge press before it took about 1 month to press a million pounds. It can be done it just takes a lot of time. Landfill cost would be very expensive as well. The first set of samples go out next week with a 14-day turnaround for results.

Mayor Buckley also mentioned the DRI projects. C.P. Ward would like to get some of the work done for the Steets and Alleyways project this fall. They would break for the winter and resume work in the spring. The James St Park project will be rebid at the end of September. He thinks that they will probably start working next year. There are inside projects that they could start working on at the pool house in the winter. They didn't want to break the projects up into smaller projects. They wanted to keep it as a whole.
