Mayor Buckley discussed the Maple City Softball application that was submitted for the upcoming season. All agreed to approve the application and the clerk will send a letter to notify the organization.

Chief Brzozowski said they have been conducting COVID testing clinics at the Art Center at least once a week for the last few weeks and they have had few positive tests. The results are forwarded on to the County.

Bud Burdett submitted and explained the Codes yearly report. Numbers are up from last year, phone call numbers were higher because of the building being in lock down. He also discussed the issue of tenants leaving garbage behind that has become an on-going problem.

Ted submitted his yearly drug arrest report, explaining that other drugs are being laced with Fentanyl. The department used thirty-eight (38) vials of Narcan this year on nineteen (19) people. The D.I.V.E.R.T. program, started last year, had twenty-seven people enrolled.

Mayor discussed the possibility of a St. Patrick's Day parade. This is an "unsponsored, unorganized" parade that has not been held the past two years due to New York State restrictions.
