- Codes Official Bud Burdett has submitted the final report for the Zombie Property grant. He reported that the county tax auction is July 12 and there are 10-12 properties from the City of Hornell that will be up for auction.
- Chief Murray reported that there has been a spike in criminal arrests and a majority of the arrests are drug arrests. The new officers are doing well; Hamilton has completed the academy and is doing field training. Thurston is attending the academy at Alfred State and Commissioner Richardson said he

is doing well. Murray reported that the department is still struggling with the number of vehicles being down.
