MISCELLANEOUS:

Alderman Buckley addressed the Committee on behalf of Wegman's. They will be holding the 2nd Annual Hometown Hero 5K on June 16. The route will be the same as last year. There were over 700 participants last year and they are anticipating 1000+ this year. A motion was made by Sengstock and seconded by Hogan to approve the 5k. Mayor Hogan noted that next year the Seneca St. Bridge will be out so the organizers should bear that in mind when planning the route.

Chief Smith reported that they are in the third month of the 911 transition. It has been going well. Some people have complained about the number of questions asked by 911 operators. Smith said that the emergency is reported immediately and the additional questions assist the responders.

The Police Department will be updating computers in four of the cruisers to keep up with 911. Chief Murray got a grant to purchase a new car but will instead use the money for the computers.

FCC regulations will require emergency services to have narrow band in the next few years. Chief Smith said the Fire Department has already done this and Chief Murray will reach out to the Fire Department for assistance in doing so at the Police Department.
