Day 3 – Space Center Houston & Brenham

After a leisurely morning along the Gulf Coast, we depart Galveston and travel north to Space Center Houston, home of America's human spaceflight program. Enjoy the famous NASA Tram Tour and fascinating exhibits showcasing the history of space exploration, astronauts, and mission control. From Houston, we continue into the rolling countryside of central Texas to Brenham, known for its small-town charm and Texas heritage. This evening, relax and enjoy dinner with the group as we prepare to enter the scenic Hill Country tomorrow. (B, D)

Day 4 – Texas Hill Country & Fredericksburg

Today we journey west into the beautiful Texas Hill Country, where ranchlands, vineyards, and rolling hills create one of the state's most scenic regions. Along the way, visit the LBJ Boyhood Home in Johnson City and learn about the early life of President Lyndon B. Johnson. Later, enjoy a winery tasting overlooking the Hill Country landscape before arriving in the German-influenced town of Fredericksburg. This evening, enjoy a wonderful dinner and time to explore the charming shops, galleries, and atmosphere of historic Main Street. (B, L, D)

Day 5 – Fredericksburg & Wine Country

This morning we visit the outstanding National Museum of the Pacific War, one of the finest military museums in the United States and dedicated to the Pacific Theater of World War II. After lunch in downtown Fredericksburg, enjoy another taste of Texas wine country with a visit to one of the Hill Country's celebrated wineries. The afternoon offers time to relax, browse Fredericksburg's unique boutiques, or simply enjoy the slower pace of this charming town before another memorable dinner together this evening. (B, L, D)

Day 6 – Gruene & San Antonio

Leaving the Hill Country behind, we stop in the historic village of Gruene, famous for its preserved buildings, antique shops, and legendary dance hall. From there we continue to San Antonio, one of Texas' most vibrant and historic cities. Visit the legendary The Alamo before settling into our beautiful River Walk hotel for a two-night stay. The evening is yours to enjoy the lively atmosphere, restaurants, music, and charm of the famous San Antonio River Walk. (B)

Day 7 – Missions, The Pearl & Tower Views

Today we discover more of San Antonio's unique blend of Spanish, Mexican, and Texas heritage. Visit the beautiful San Antonio Missions, now a UNESCO World Heritage Site, and learn about the city's early colonial history. Later, enjoy free time and lunch at the trendy Pearl District, filled with restaurants, boutiques, and local flavor. This afternoon, ascend the Tower of the Americas for spectacular panoramic views of the city before gathering for a special farewell dinner along the River Walk to celebrate our unforgettable Texas journey. Day 8 – Austin & Journey Home

Our final day begins with a scenic drive north to Austin, the energetic capital of Texas. Tour the impressive Texas State Capitol before enjoying legendary Texas barbecue for lunch. Afterwards, spend free time exploring South Congress Avenue, one of Austin's most popular districts known for local shops, music culture, and iconic Texas character.
