ABOUT OUR SHUTTERS

Hand crafted in the UK, our shutters utilise a polyvinyl composite material, with each component securely joined through mechanical means. This method not only preserves the integrity of the materials but also allows for straightforward disassembly of the structural elements. Engineered to resist moisture absorption, our shutters effectively combat the growth of mold and mildew, making them ideal for high-humidity environments like bathrooms and kitchens. We take immense pride in our British manufacturing. Our dedication to the "British" label is a core part of our identity. We offer competitive lead times and exceptional quality, backed by a guaranteed 10-year warranty.

SLIMMER STILE

We are reducing the size of our stiles and astragal by 10.8mm. This change creates additional space in the louvre area, enhancing light control and adjustable privacy. Additionally, we are decreasing the size of the square stile aluminium section. Still maintaining its strength, making it more visually appealing for all shutter styles, particularly the café style. Say goodbye to bungs!

FULLY REINFORCED LOUVRE

These louvres feature internal support made from 6063 aluminium alloy, which offers outstanding strength and longevity. Perfect for expansive windows or busy spaces, their reinforced design allows them to endure higher pressure and frequent use without compromising their shape.

FULLY ADJUSTABLE T-POST

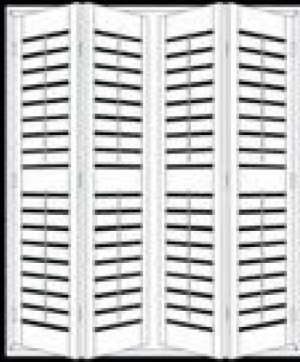

INVISIBLE TILT

Typically, this Invisible Tilt System is a mechanism embedded in the stile on one side of the panel, featuring a rack-and-pinion structure. At the end of each louver, there is a pinion, and these pinions are interconnected by racks, so that when you tilt one louver, the mechanism transfers the movement to the rest of the louvers. This creates a clean and streamlined look without the need for a visible tilt rod in the centre.

ANTI SCRATCH PAINT

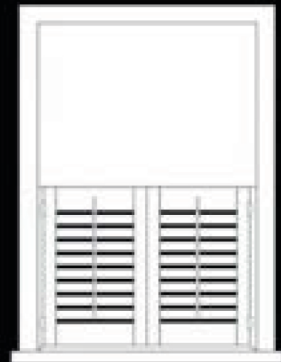

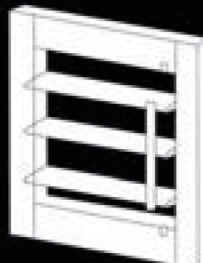

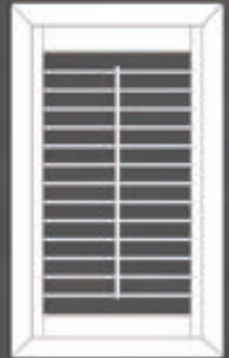
63MM LOUVRE

Although they let in a bit less light than larger sizes, the extra louvers per panel make the space feel warm and welcoming. Smaller louvers provide increased privacy and less natural light, making it more suitable for areas requiring more privacy, such as bedrooms or bathrooms.

76MM LOUVRE

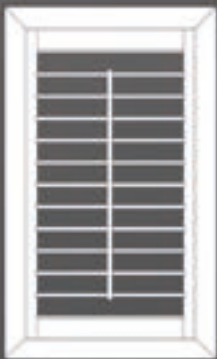

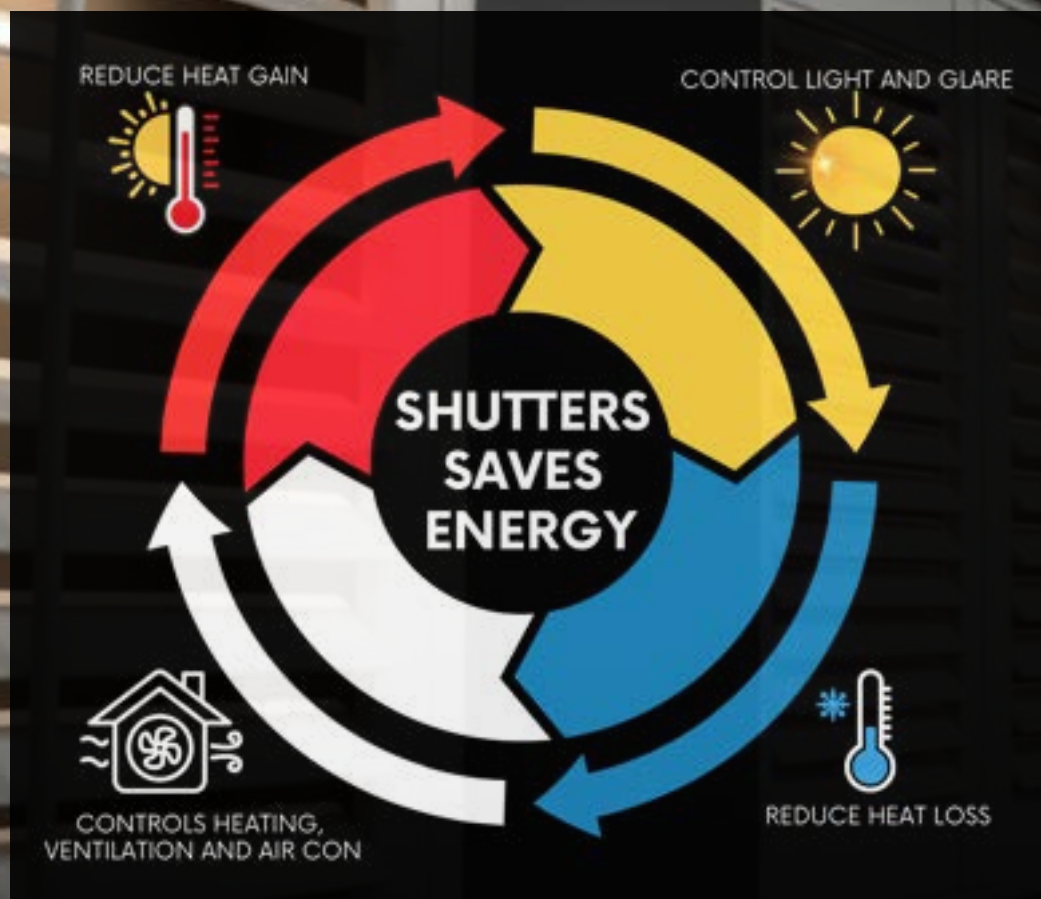

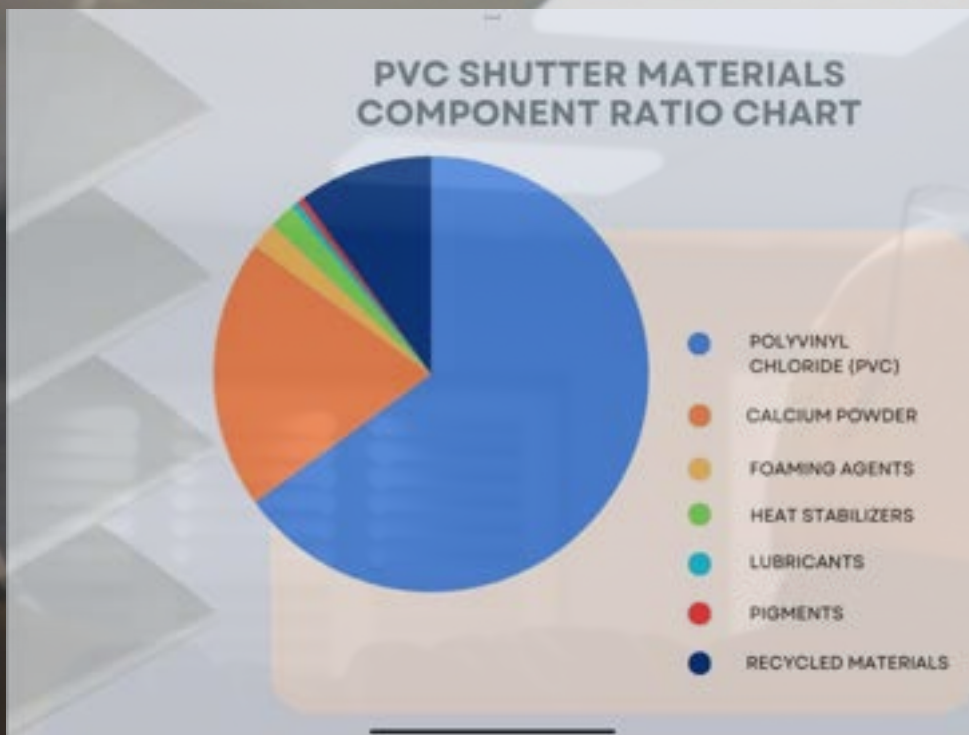
PERFECT FIT

In contrast to conventional shutters that necessitate drilling or screwing into the window frame, Perfect Fit Shutters are engineered to effortlessly clip into position.



The increasing energy costs are a hot topic, making it wise to consider ways to cut down on our usage. Did you know that windows account for 25-30% of energy consumption due to heat gain and loss? This is the perfect time to explore options for enhancing your home's energy efficiency. Our louvres are designed to be closed in an upright position, which allows you to control the airflow in a room and reduces condensation on the windows. Shutters not only add a touch of style but also serve a practical purpose by providing an extra layer of insulation, which can enhance the temperature and comfort levels in your home. For homes built after 2002, double glazing is a requirement to meet regulations and energy rating standards. By adding shutters to your windows, you essentially upgrade them from double glazing to a triple glazing level of efficiency.

New independent research by the University of Salford's Energy House Labs has demonstrated that shutters can reduce heat loss through windows by up to 28%



POLYVINYL CHLORIDE

The backbone of our plantation shutter materials, which offers strength and durability. Known for its rigidity and resistance to moisture and decay, it ensures longevity and consistent performance.

CALCIUM POWDER

In the formulation of our shutters materials, we introduce calcium powder to augment stability and strength. This enhances rigidity without compromising the shutter's overall quality. The proportion of calcium powder directly influences the density and weight of the shutter profiles.

PROCESSING AGENTS

Foaming Agents: These create a lightweight, cellular structure, contributing to better insulation.

Heat Stabilisers: Essential during manufacturing, they prevent degradation and discolouration under heat.

Lubricants: They aid in the smooth processing of PVC, leading to finer finishes.

RECYCLED MATERIALS

In our manufacturing process, we ensure that the addition of recycled does not exceed 15%. The use of recycled materials in our shutter parts production aligns with our commitment to sustainability, while also upholding the high-quality standards British Made Shutters is known for.

SHUTTER CARE GUIDE

To keep your plantation shutters looking their best, regular gentle cleaning is key. Here's how to care for them properly without damaging the finish.

1. Dust Gently – Weekly

Use a soft microfiber cloth, feather duster, or vacuum with a brush attachment to remove surface dust. Tilt slats open and closed to reach all sides.

2. Wipe Carefully – As Needed

For a deeper clean, lightly dampen a clean cloth with water and a mild soap. Wipe each louvre gently. Never soak or saturate.

3. Dry Immediately

Follow up with a dry, soft cloth to remove any moisture. This prevents streaks and protects the finish.

4. Avoid Harsh Products

Please do not use bleach, abrasive sponges, or chemical cleaners. These may damage the surface and reduce the lifespan of your shutters.

5. Light Touch on Hardware

Occasionally wipe down hinges and frames to keep everything looking fresh and working smoothly.

6. Tension Screw

If the louvres are feeling a little bit loose, HAND tighten the screw on the side. If unsure ask your installer for more info.

Your shutters are built to last—thank you for taking care of them. By treating your shutters with care, they'll stay looking beautiful for years to come—just one of the many benefits of choosing quality, British-made craftsmanship.

When checking the overall visual characteristics and aesthetics, the following should be observed:

Viewing distance and lighting:
3m for exterior products in diffuse daylight
2m for interior products with lighting suitable for normal room use.

Viewing angle:
Perpendicular to the surface being checked.

Viewing aids:
Naked eye (and any corrective glasses if applicable).

The discussion surrounding Hardwood and Polyvinyl shutters has persisted, with each option presenting their own. Wood is frequently celebrated as the superior choice but the characteristics of wood can vary significantly depending on the region. Russian hardwood is widely recognised as one of the finest types available and also the most expensive. The woods most frequently used; include Basswood and Paulownia. Basswood is generally softer than many hardwoods, making it more susceptible to dents and scratches. Paulownia wood features a naturally coarse and porous grain, which necessitates the application of acrylic filler before painting to achieve a smooth finish. These adaptations render the product more artificial than we realise, failing to meet the standards we assume it achieves. The question at hand is whether you are truly receiving the high-quality wood for which you are paying a premium, or if you are being sold a subpar, artificially manufactured product.
