1. In order to receive your suddenly, <u>preparation</u> is required:

A. Open the doors: 2 Chron. 29:1-3

B. Confess sin: 2 Chron. 29:4-11

C. Clean out the house: 2 Chron. 29:16

2. In order to receive suddenly, put <u>praise</u> in your <u>heart</u> and let it come out of your <u>mouth</u>: 2 Chron. 29:25-28

3. In order to receive your suddenly, <u>pray</u> the <u>Word</u> of <u>God</u> with <u>faith</u>: 2 Chron. 29:29-30

Bottom Line: <u>Get ready</u>, believe without <u>wavering</u>, your <u>suddenly</u> is <u>sure</u> to come!

3. The seed of praise: Acts 16:25B

4. The seed of <u>proclamation</u>: Acts 16:25C

Bottom Line: When you seed your suddenly, look for your <u>manifestation</u> of God's <u>presence</u>: Acts 16:26

- 1. The <u>secrecy</u> of the <u>time</u>: Mark 13:32
- 2. The seriousness of the moment: Mark 13:33
- 3. The steadfastness of the work: Mark 13:34
- 4. The signs to consider: Mark 13:33-35A
- 5. The suddenly of His coming: Mark 13:35-36
- 6. The sadness of those left behind: Mark 13:37

Bottom Line: This suddenly will happen in a <u>twinkling</u> of an <u>eye! Get Ready!!!</u>

Sunday, July 26, 2020

#### **Suddenly, There Was A Storm**

Matthew 14:15-33

- 1. The <u>mess</u>: Matt. 14:22-24
  - A. When in the mess you are governed by His providence: Matt. 14:22
  - B. Even when the mess is at its <u>worse</u> you are still growing by His plan: Matt. 14:22
  - C. When in the mess you are in His <u>prayers</u>: Matt. 14:23, Mark 6:47-48

#### 2. The miracle:

- A. Forgetting the miracle: Matt. 14:19-21, Mark 6:51-52
- B. His <u>presence</u> is your <u>miracle</u>: Matt. 14:25
- C. God is never <u>late</u>, never <u>early</u>, never in a <u>hurry</u>, but always <u>right</u> on <u>time</u>: Matt. 14:25

#### 3. The message:

- A. You are guarded by His power: Mark 4:38-41
- B. You are guided by His purpose: Matt. 14:22
- C. You are guaranteed by His plan: John 6:21

Bottom Line: As a child of God, God has not <u>promised</u> you <u>smooth</u> <u>sailing</u>, but He has promised you a <u>safe landing!</u>
