
PRESS RELEASE

You will find hereafter a copy of the letter Innocence en danger France sent today to the Prosecutor of Republic.

«Mr. Prosecutor of the Republic,

As President of the Association INNOCENCE EN DANGER, whose statutory purpose is the protection and defense of the child victim, in the world, of any form of sexual exploitation, any form of endangerment, of physical, psychological or sexual assault or violence, I must bring to your attention the facts relating to the so-called «Jeffrey Epstein» case pursuant to the provisions of Article 40 of the Code of Criminal Procedure. The French association INNOCENCE EN DANGER collaborating with the offices of Innocence En Danger implanted in many countries, including the United States, I was contacted in my capacity as President by investigators and journalists at the heart of this case, with the aim of allowing the identification and the testimony of possible victims of Mr EPSTEIN, on the French territory.

As reported in the US and French media, Mr. Jeffrey EPSTEIN was arrested by the FBI on July 6 when he landed his private jet at Teterboro Airport, New Jersey, after his stay in Paris.

Mr. EPSTEIN was indicted by the Federal Court for «sexual exploitation of minors and criminal conspiracy to sexually exploit minors», and the first elements of the investigation would point to the existence of a «sprawling network of young people» teenage girls reduced to sexual slavery «in the United States (article published on July 27, 2019 in the Journal L'Express).

An American independent investigative journalist says that after many years of investigation on Mr. Epstein, there are «many tracks» putting «in contact Jeffrey Epstein with France» (article previously cited).

The same journalist talks about relations maintained by Mr. EPSTEIN with French, some of whose names appear in a «black book», a kind of contacts directory of the latter entitled «Massage Paris», unveiled by the American press and whose image has been published by the Journal L'Express.

According to the information provided to me in my capacity as President of the American Bureau INNOCENCE IN DANGER, Mr. EPSTEIN would have stayed several weeks in his apartment located at 22 avenue Foch in the 16th arrondissement of Paris, before his arrest on July 6 last.

These stays on the French territory were regular and it is up to the investigators acting under your authority to shed light on the use of the apartment acquired by Mr EPSTEIN, with regard to the revelations made by one of the victims identified in the United States that she had «traveled a lot with him as his sex slave, especially in Paris».

It appears that New Mexico has already initiated an investigation into the conditions of acquisition of land / property by Mr. EPSTEIN, which would have resulted in the identification of two victims.

It would be incomprehensible under these conditions that the French judicial authority remains deaf and blind to all the evidence and evidence revealed by the US judicial and investigative authorities.

Indeed, it is to be feared the existence of victim (s) in France acts of Mr. EPSTEIN, given his judicial past as the elements revealed on his personality.

It is up to you, Mr. Prosecutor, to seize the information revealed by the media and the American judicial authorities, to open a preliminary inquiry and to implement international police and judicial cooperation aimed at the demonstration of the truth about the nature of Mr. EPSTEIN's activities in PARIS, the frequency of his stays in PARIS and their motive (by the study of his flight diaries in particular), the identities of the French contacts who favored or helped sexual exploitation minors both in the United States and possibly on French territory.
