WPGA Junior Golf ROADMAP



1 The **Drive, Chip and Putt Championship** is a FREE skills competition for boys and girls ages 7-15. Juniors earn points in golf's core areas - driving, chipping and putting with hopes of advancing through qualifying stages. The top performers earn a trip to the National Finals at Augusta National. Visit www.drivechipandputt.com for more information.



2 **PGA Jr. League** is a fun, social and inclusive opportunity for girls and boys 17 and under to learn how to play the game in a mildly competitive setting. Like other youth sports, players wear numbered jerseys and play against other teams in their area while PGA and LPGA Professionals serve as coaches. Join a team near you by checking out www.pgajrleague.com.



3 The **Par 3 Tour** is the next step in the progression of a junior golfer interested in competitive golf. This tour is a great way for youth ages 7-18 to practice their golfing skills while making new friends in a tournament setting. We host events in major markets such as Madison and Milwaukee.



4 Located around the state, the **Future Tour** offers a 9-hole tournament experience at regulation length golf courses. Age divisions are 12-14 and 11 and under for boys and girls.



5 This tour was started for players age 10 to 16 with two objectives in mind:

- Introduce younger players to playing 18-hole events at shorter/easier distances than a Junior Tour.
- Give older players a chance to improve their skills at 18-hole events (while playing shorter/easier distances) so you can score better and have more confidence.



6 The **Junior Tour** is our largest series with over 60 18-hole events all over Wisconsin. Age divisions are 16-18, 14-15, 12-13 for boys and girls. Course yardage is 6,000-6,350 for boys and 5,000-5,350 for girls.



7 The goal of the **Players Tour** is to have the top junior players in the state compete on golf courses set up appropriately for a high level of play. Juniors must meet a Golf Handicap requirement to play on this tour. (Boys index under 9.1 and Girls index under 16.1). Course yardage is 6,600-6,800 for boys and 5,700-5,900 for girls.

CHANGES & UPDATES FOR 2026



REGISTRATION BEGINS APRIL 8TH

Juniors Members can register for events online starting on April 8th at 6 p.m. April 22nd will be last day for members to register before non-members. Starting April 23rd, all non-members can register for tournaments. Take advantage of this period to become a junior member and register for events you want to play in before they fill up.

EVENTS & UPDATES

- We will have lottery drawings to several events that will have high demand. Players will have the window from April 8th at 6pm to the end of day on April 14th to register for each event lottery. If, on April 15th, there are more registrants than spots, we will fill the field accordingly. You will receive notification by April 22nd whether you are in each event or on a waitlist.
- Players Tour Events handicap requirement. 7.5 for boys and 15.0 for girls. The Blackwolf Run event will be lower at 6.1 for boys and 13.1 for girls. All players tour events will be pending payments.

2026 SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATIONS

The purpose of the WPGA Junior Foundation scholarship program is to assist graduating high school and college students in financing their college education. There are 2 separate scholarship forms. One is for graduating high school seniors and the other is for current college students. Please choose the appropriate one. In 2025, the WPGA Junior Foundation awarded 38 scholarships totaling \$90,000. We anticipate awarding even more in 2026.

Junior Membership - \$110

Sibling Membership - \$60

For any junior who has one sibling already registered for the Junior Membership \$110 level. Juniors will also receive a WSGA Handicap if needed. The sibling membership is good for juniors ages 12-18. Check out all the membership benefits below!

Beginner Membership Ages 11 & Under - \$40

For juniors ages 11 and under. Juniors must not turn 12 before June 1st, 2026. **If you are also on a PGA Jr. League team you will receive a discount code from your Captain for \$40 to be used for this membership, making this membership FREE.** This membership will receive discounts of \$10 per Future and Intermediate Tour event, \$5 per X Golf County Parks event and \$5 per Par 3 event.

JUNIOR MEMBERSHIP GIFTS

- **Member only events. Select events on the WPGA Junior event schedule are reserved for members only**

- Ability to apply for one of our scholarships. All applicants must be a junior member
- Free initial lesson worth \$175 (1 1/2 hours) from any Wisconsin GolfTec store. By appointment only.

WPGA JUNIOR TOURNAMENTS RULES AND REGULATIONS

The rules and regulations below are applicable to all events and tours.

REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Beginning April 8th, members' can register online. April 22nd will be the last day for members to register for events before non-members. Starting on April 23rd, all non-members can register for tournaments. Entries will continue to be accepted until the deadline of each event. If the event is filled, the entry will be placed on the waiting list. NO REFUNDS after the entry deadline. If you cancel prior to deadline a cancellation fee will be charged.

ELIGIBILITY

Out of state residents are allowed to participate in our events. Juniors must be age 18 or under on the day of the tournament.

DEADLINE

Deadlines and field size vary by event. Late entries will not be accepted. Entries must be in by 11:59 p.m. the day of the deadline. In the event the tournament entry limit is met, a waiting list will be formed.

ELECTRONIC MEASURING DEVICES

These devices be allowed for all our junior events. A player may obtain distance information by using a device that measures distance only. Yardage obtained from these devices may be shared with fellow competitors and is not deemed to be advice.

DRESS CODE

Proper golf attire is required. Collared shirts will be required at all times when at any event site. No cutoffs, jeans or jean shorts, tank tops, or gym shorts allowed. Hats may be worn provided they are worn with the bill to the front. Metal spikes are not permitted. Players may wear shoes with non-metal spikes or tennis shoes. Girls must wear skirts/skortts appropriately on golf course. NO TUCKING OF SKIRT/SKORTTS ALLOWED.

CADDIES/ADVICE

Caddies are not permitted. Contestants must carry their own bag or use a pull cart. Outside advice is not allowed during competition play. Breach of rule results in disqualification.

WEATHER

It is the responsibility of each contestant to contact the club where the event is to be played in the case of inclement weather or conditions that would warrant re-scheduling or cancellation of the tournament. If you checked the box to receive text messages about weather, we will send text updates with any weather information throughout the summer.

PACE OF PLAY

WE WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCING THE PACE OF PLAY POLICY. DETAILS WILL BE POSTED ONLINE AND AT EACH EVENT. IF A PLAYER IS UNABLE TO FINISH THE EVENT IN A TIMELY MANNER, AS A RESULT OF ABILITY OR COURSE CONDITIONS, THE PLAYER MAY BE REMOVED FROM THE EVENT. IN SUCH A CASE, A FULL REFUND WILL BE GIVEN FOR HIS/HER ENTRY FEE.



PLAYER CODE OF CONDUCT

Any conduct inconsistent with the values of the WPGA, good sportsmanship, or that may be detrimental in any manner to the WPGA Junior events will not be tolerated. Any major infraction may lead to a two-stroke penalty or disqualification. Violations may result in removal from future events. Quitting or walking off the golf course during a round will not be tolerated. All players MUST turn in their scorecard when the round is completed. If you are suspected of recording incorrect scores or purposely violating the Rules of Golf, measures will be taken to monitor your scores and actions during future WPGA events. If a player suspects another of dishonest conduct or violating a rule of golf, the player should seek a rules official as soon as possible to handle the situation. Cheating is strictly prohibited.

Player Code of Conduct Penalties

The Wisconsin PGA Junior Foundation may assess any or all of the following penalties based on the players' Code of Conduct violation:

- **One-stroke penalty to the player**
 - Swearing
 - Club throwing
 - Damage to the golf course or another player's belongings
 - Not fixing a ball mark
 - Not replacing your divot
- **Two-stroke penalty to the player**
 - Wilful or intentional infractions of all examples above
 - A second violation of the above following a one-stroke penalty
- **Disqualification for the player**
 - Cheating
 - Association with drugs, alcohol, smoking, vaping, or chewing tobacco products
 - Gambling
 - Display of vulgar or abusive behavior
 - Conduct deemed disrespectful to a fellow competitor, spectators, tournament official, host site personnel or WPGA staff
- **Suspension from tournament participation**
 - Continued pattern of violations above
 - Extreme situations involving any of the above violations
 - Players suspended from future play will be refunded

Any violation of one or more items in the Player Code of Conduct deemed egregious by the WPGA is grounds for immediate removal of the player from the tournament and host facility and may result in the loss of privilege to participate in WPGA Junior Golf tournaments for the player indefinitely.

As a condition of participation in and entry into all events conducted by the WPGA, all participants and spectators acknowledge and agree to the foregoing codes of conduct and rules and that the WPGA is granted the final and binding authority to enforce the codes of conduct and rules, to impose penalties and that its decisions shall be final and binding on all participants and spectators.

SPECTATOR CODE OF CONDUCT

The Wisconsin PGA Junior Foundation takes pride in the conduct of its players, host facilities, and spectators. To make events enjoyable for everyone, all participants and spectators must adhere to the Spectator Code of Conduct. These are guidelines covering specific examples, however, the Wisconsin PGA reserves the right to consider actions outside of these guidelines as violation of the Spectator Code of Conduct.

Not Allowed:

- Spectators must not provide advice or tips to players throughout a round.
- Spectators are not caddies and may not perform the duties of a caddie. This includes but is not limited to tending the flagstick, raking the bunkers, and providing advice.
- Spectators should not assist with rulings. WPGA Staff should be contacted for all rulings, as any player receiving a ruling from a spectator will be subject to a penalty that can be associated with a wrong ruling.
- Spectators must not verbally or physically abuse, threaten, or disrespect a fellow spectator, player, volunteer, WPGA Staff, or other person conducting, participating in, hosting, or attending a WPGA Junior Foundation event.
- Spectators must not make disparaging remarks about the host facility.
- Spectators must not drive the golf cart off of the cart path, even in the event of helping forecaddy and looking for a lost ball. If a course does not have a cart path, spectators must keep a reasonable distance away from the players and stay in the rough.
- Spectators are not permitted in the Scoring Area to assist players with score disputes.

Allowed:

- Spectators are required to stay 20 yards away from players throughout a round. Staying on the cart path is required unless helping look for a lost ball.
- Spectators may assist in forecaddying and searching for a lost ball.
- Spectators must adhere to the dress code outlined for participants.
- Spectators may carry water, umbrellas, jackets, towels and food for a player.

Spectator Code of Conduct Penalties

Any violation of one or more items in the Spectator Code of Conduct is grounds for immediate removal of the infringing party or their player from the tournament and host facility and may result in the loss of privilege to participate in WPGA Junior Golf tournaments for the spectator/or player indefinitely. The Wisconsin PGA Junior Foundation may assess any or all of the following penalties based on the Spectators' Code of Conduct violation:

- Issue a verbal or written warning
- Enforce a one-stroke penalty to the spectator's player
- Enforce a two-stroke penalty to the spectator's player
- Spectator removal from tournament
- Spectator indefinite suspension from future events
- Such other penalties deemed appropriate by the WPGA

As a condition of participation in and entry into all events conducted by the WPGA, all participants and spectators acknowledge and agree to the foregoing codes of conduct and rules and that the WPGA is granted the final and binding authority to enforce the codes of conduct and rules, to impose penalties and that its decisions shall be final and binding on all participants and spectators.

The WPGA Junior Foundation has teamed up with the WSGA to bring the Junior Girls Championship back to a prominent event for girls. This event has been expanded to a three day event. Each girl will play a qualifying round on July 27. Players will then be seeded into flights. The Match Play field will be limited to the first 88 players. In 2026, players that do not qualify for Match Play will receive a refund on entry fee. Format: Competition will be match play. Players will be put into flights based on their 18-hole stroke play qualifying score on Monday. The single-elimination matches will begin on Tuesday morning.

Format: Competition will be match play. All players will be flighted into flights based on their 18-hole stroke play qualifying score on Monday. The single-elimination matches will begin on Tuesday morning. Matches will then continue Tuesday afternoon and semi finals on Wednesday morning and Finals matches on Wednesday afternoon.

Eligibility: Girls who have not reached their 19th birthday as of July 27th, 2026.
Girls are recommended to have a WSGA handicap index of 24 or less.

Entry Fee: \$150 fee includes green fees, tee gift, range balls and lunch(es).
ENTRY DEADLINE: July 20th.

Awards: Prizes will be awarded to Champion and Runner-up of each flight. A permanent trophy (on display at Golf House) will be engraved with the Championship Flight winner's name.

Eligibility: *INVITE ONLY* Boys who have not reached their 19th birthday as of July 27th, 2026.

Entry Fee: \$150 fee includes green fees, tee gift, range balls and lunch(es). ENTRY DEADLINE: July 20th.

WPGA JUNIOR TOUR RULES AND REGULATIONS

TOUR DESCRIPTION

Our most popular tour for juniors ages 12-18, with tournaments located all around the state of Wisconsin. These events are 18-hole stroke play tournaments geared towards juniors of all abilities. Age divisions are 12-13, 14-15, 16-18 for boys and girls. Course yardage is 6,000-6,350 for boys and 5,000-5,350 for girls. Boys in the 12-13 division will play from the forward tees. They will play a yardage range from about 5,700 to 6,000 based on course tees.

FORMAT

18-hole stroke play events. Six divisions as follows: Boys 16-18, Boys 14-15, Boys 12-13, Girls 16-18, Girls 14-15, Girls 12-13. The top three finishers will be awarded in each division. If less than five players in a division, only the top two will receive awards. Age on the day of the event determines division.

POINTS

Player of the year awards will be awarded for 16-18 division, 14-15 division and 12-13 division on the Junior Tour for boys and girls. Player of the Year points are based on overall finish against the full field for both Boys/Girls. The points list was redone for the 2026 season. Make sure to check out the updated point structure for our events. Please reference the WI Player of the Year spreadsheet located on www.wiscjuniorgolf.com for more information.

WEATHER POLICY

If an event is cancelled in its entirety, refunds will be issued to your BlueGolf account. If you wish to receive refund by credit card you must contact Wisconsin PGA staff. 

TOUR DESCRIPTION

We are excited to have our title sponsor, The American Family Insurance Championship, back for the Players Tour. The American Family Insurance Championship will take place at TPC Wisconsin on June 5-7. This is a Champions Tour event and tickets are available online. They will also be supporting a scholarship of \$3,750 to a boy and \$3,750 to a girl this year. The scholarship application is on the website and the deadline is April 23rd.

The goal of the Players Tour is to have the top junior players in the state compete on golf courses set up appropriately for a high level of play. The Players Tour is an Invite only tour open to players ages 12-18. This is our top-level tour in Wisconsin. All Players Tour events are nationally ranked by Junior Golf Scoreboard, as well as recognized by AJGA Performance Based Entry stars. Golf course set-up is usually between 6,500 and 6,800 yards for boys and between 5,600 and 5,900 yards for girls.

Who is invited to play on the Players Tour:

The American Family Insurance Championship Players Tour is by INVITE ONLY. To be invited to play in the American Family Insurance Championship Players Tour events, you must have a qualifying WSGA handicap. Boys must be under a 7.5 index and girls must be under an 15.0 index. If you meet the above handicap requirements, contact Andy Landenberger or Ashton Angst at the Wisconsin PGA Section office to verify your handicap and be eligible to register for events the American Family Insurance Championship Players Tour.

The Players Tour event at Blackwolf Run will have a lower handicap requirement. Boys must be under a 6.1 index and girls must be under a 13.1 index.

How does Players Tour event registration work?

We will continue doing a random lottery process for all Players Tour events. Players will have the window from April 8 at 6pm to the end of day on April 14 to register for each Players Tour event lottery. If, on April 15, there are more registrants than spots, a random drawing will be held for those that meet the eligibility criteria. 
