Grace United Methodist Church is entering an exciting new season of ministry this summer. As we give thanks for the faithful leadership of Rev. Dr. Cathy Jamieson, who is retiring, and Rev. Ashley Buchanan, who is taking a step back to discern next steps in ministry and follow the voice of the Good Shepherd, we also look forward to welcoming two new pastors to the Grace family. Beginning Sunday, June 28, Rev. Terry Fleming will serve as Senior Pastor and Rev. Jessica Kight will serve as Associate Pastor.

Rev. Terry Fleming, Senior Pastor



Rev. Terry Fleming comes to Grace UMC with many years of pastoral leadership within the United Methodist Church. Most recently, he served as District Superintendent for the Florence District, providing leadership and oversight to more than 90 congregations across the region. Prior to serving as superintendent, Rev. Fleming pastored congregations in Boiling Springs and Ellore, SC, where he helped strengthen worship participation, develop small group ministries, and expand outreach and mission efforts. Throughout his ministry, he has focused on helping congregations move forward with strong leadership, thoughtful planning, and a deep commitment to the mission of the church.

Rev. Fleming earned a Bachelor of Science in Management and Marketing from Liberty University and later completed his Master of Divinity at Lutheran Theological Southern Seminary. He describes ministry as both a calling and a joy, especially in preaching, teaching, and walking alongside people through the important moments of life and faith. Rev. Fleming is passionate about helping congregations grow in their faith and in their welcome to others.

Rev. Fleming and his wife, Carla, have been married since 1988. Carla recently retired after a career as a physical therapist and has served in music ministry in several congregations as a pianist and organist. They have three adult children and enjoy spending time with their family and grandchildren.

Rev. Jessica Kight, Associate Pastor

Rev. Jessica Kight brings a heart for teaching, pastoral care, and community-centered ministry. She currently serves rural congregations in the Swansea and Wagener area and looks forward to joining the Grace UMC ministry team. Jessica's call to ministry grew out of a deeply personal season of faith and discernment. Her faith was shaped in part through her involvement with Salkehatchie Summer Service. She was also mentored and encouraged in her spiritual journey by her pastor at Williston UMC, Rev. Cindy Fuller, who is also part of the Grace family.



Before entering pastoral ministry, Jessica served in several leadership roles within her church, including Administrative Council member, church treasurer, worship leader, and Sunday school teacher, experiences that helped prepare her for pastoral leadership.

Jessica earned a Bachelor's degree in Business Administration from the University of South Carolina Aiken and later completed a Master's degree in Adult Education. She is continuing her ministerial education through the United Methodist Course of Study program.

A lifelong learner and teacher at heart, Jessica enjoys helping others discover deeper meaning in Scripture and grow in their faith journey. Jessica lives in Aiken with her mother, whom she helps care for, and a Great Dane puppy named Henry, who is being trained as a therapy dog.

Blessings from Sanctuary Music!

As we approach this time of reflection and resurrection, you are invited and encouraged to take part in our Holy Week Services. Holy Thursday Communion will be a special time of fellowship and preparation, aided in music by our steadfast Chancel Choir, and **Dr. Keely Rhodes**, soloist. Dr. Rhodes is professor of voice at USCA and will offer the *Lord's Prayer* as well as *Panis Angelicus* by Caesar Franck.

Good Friday will be a bit out of our norm but still maintain our usual sense of purpose and depth. All of the music—hymns, anthems, organ music—is inspired by the early American musical tradition. These pieces will come from our shared vernacular history of shape-note tunes, spirituals, and early gospel hymns of the 19th century. In that spirit, we are privileged to have Edgefield's own, **Mr. Brooker Strom** deliver some of this music in its original, vernacular style, along with Chancel Choir. You will want to see, hear, sense, and absorb this service of divine word and music from our own soil.

Easter Sunday will feature our own **Charlie Mraz** and a familiar face at Grace, **Patryk Turner**, on trumpets. Widor's infamous "Toccata" will close our service as only it can.

Finally, mark your calendar for a very special musical event! Concert organist, **Dr. Nathaniel Gumbs** will give a free recital on May 1st at 7 p.m., at Reid Memorial Presbyterian Church. Dr. Gumbs is the Director of Music at Riverside Church - NYC, and formerly Director of Music at Yale Chapel (the youngest person ever appointed to that position!). Dr. Gumbs is also a dear friend of our own Chris Leysath, and will present a performance like you've never seen. Google him beforehand and get ready to buckle your seatbelts!

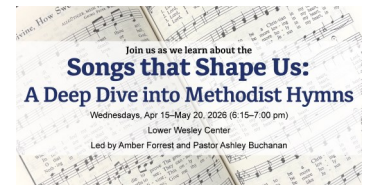

During the Easter season, we have two wonderful class offerings that both look at our Methodist history from two very different angles:

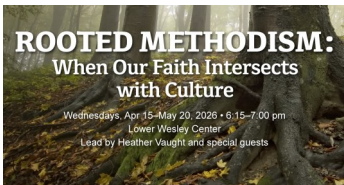
• **Songs that Shape Us: A Deep Dive into Methodist Hymns**

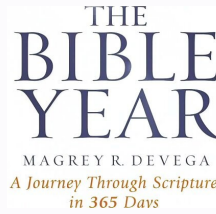

The Bible Year Updates - Heading into Exile

Only a few generations after the heights of King David’s glory, the Kingdom of Israel is now split in two. From their separate capitals, Israel and Judah take turns occasionally getting it right and most often failing miserably to live as God has commanded. Eventually, God allows the consequence of their choices to catch up with them...foreign invaders like Assyria and Babylon show up on the scene to threaten the safety of the people.



In April, we will be reading through 1 & 2 Chronicles, Ezra, Nehemiah, Esther, and Job. The majority of these books are historical narratives that deal with the people of God in Exile (Job is its own special type of wisdom literature).

Grace! If you haven't heard the news, ***The Way will be launching Sunday worship services on April 12th!***

If you *have* heard the news, I bet you have a lot of questions, so here is some Q&A:



Q: How will Sundays at The Way work?

A: We will meet for a simple lunch at 1pm, followed by worship at 2pm. *The lunch hour is optional*, and both gives time for GUMC folks who want to join in worship to keep their Sunday lunch routine, while also allows for "The Way" crowd to gather and have a meal time before worship. This is all a pilot program, so structure and logistics *will* change based on response, but to start, lunch will be prepared by Rev. Patrick and 1 or 2 weekly helpers on rotation, unless more of The Way crowd volunteers to bring dishes! *Preparing a food is NOT at all expected for you to attend Worship at 2pm.*



Q: Will The Way still have Thursday Nights?

A: Yes! We will still meet for Thursday nights, where we will keep our spirit of creativity with different event offerings! In addition, the added time for me (Rev. Patrick) to focus on The Way means that we will also be able to offer more special events! Be on the lookout!

Q: Does this mean The Way isn't a part of Grace anymore?

A: The Way is still joined with Grace UMC and under the current grant agreement. The UMC SC Conference is still covering Rev. Patrick's salary through 2026. What has changed right now is the focus of that grant-funded position, towards developing the Way on the foundation that has been built. We have designed the current weekly schedule with people of Grace in mind, as many GUMC folks participate in The Way activities- that's how planted churches thrive!

We hope for your participation & prayers in this new season as we continue reaching people for Christ with a joyful faith!

From the Treasurer

With last month's payment, the GUMC Wesley Center mortgage principal fell to below \$1M. The original mortgage was refinanced at \$2.25M in February 2017 with a reduction in our monthly payment from over \$30K per month to the current \$15,752.77 per month. This allowed us to direct additional funds to staff, programs, and campus maintenance. The projected mortgage retirement date at the current monthly payment is November 15, 2031.
