John Newell, also a founder of LifeSong, will share reflections, and the band will do a medley of songs that God has used to speak to our congregation. CUBA MISSION TEAM October 1-13, 2025, Cindy & Jerry Fuller



Prince of Peace Methodist - Cuba

Many of you have welcomed us back from our Cuba mission team and ask how it was. In one word, HARD -- perhaps the hardest mission team we have been on and we have been on a lot of international mission teams to various countries. There were 10 of us on this UNITED METHODIST VOLUNTEERS IN MISSION (UMVIM) team - folks from Idaho, Texas, Virginia, Georgia & South Carolina.

The Methodist Church of Cuba was our host and we spent our first evening at the Methodist Conference Center in Havana. Early the next day, a 4 hour drive took us to the Methodist Camp site, IGLESIA METHODISTA EN CUBA -Campamento Canaan, our home for the next 5 days. We were blessed to have electricity 3-5 hours per day most days. The week prior to our arrival in Cuba the island had no power. It was HOT! The staff at Canaan were gracious and so very grateful for our presence. Our two projects were painting the walls of a dormitory and the

construction of a concrete wall on the second floor of an adjoining building. Not hard jobs if they had had adequate funds to provide the materials.

That's the life of the Cuban people. Eleven years ago when Jerry & I were in Cuba on a study tour, conditions were so much better. Now widespread shortages, high inflation, and infrastructure collapse has created what one can only call "pitiful conditions".

In the midst of such poverty, is the Methodist Church of Cuba – over 500 churches scattered across the island. We had the privilege to worship in three of them. Such excitement in worship, such depth of prayer, such dependence on God. In reality, they know that all they really have is God! It was a wonderful experience to worship with these our brothers & sisters in Christ.

In years past UMVIM use to average 2 mission teams to Cuba every month. In 2025, we were only the 5th team, with a team from North Carolina hopefully going this November. It is sad, because now more than ever, Cuba could use our help. Please keep the Cuban people in your prayers and especially the Cuban Methodist Church.
