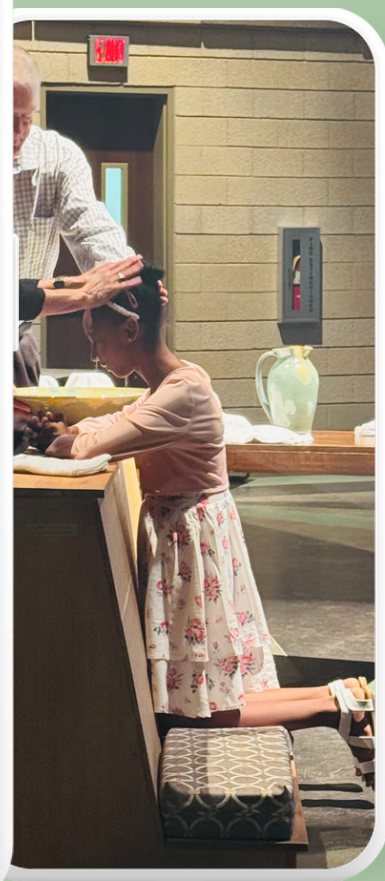

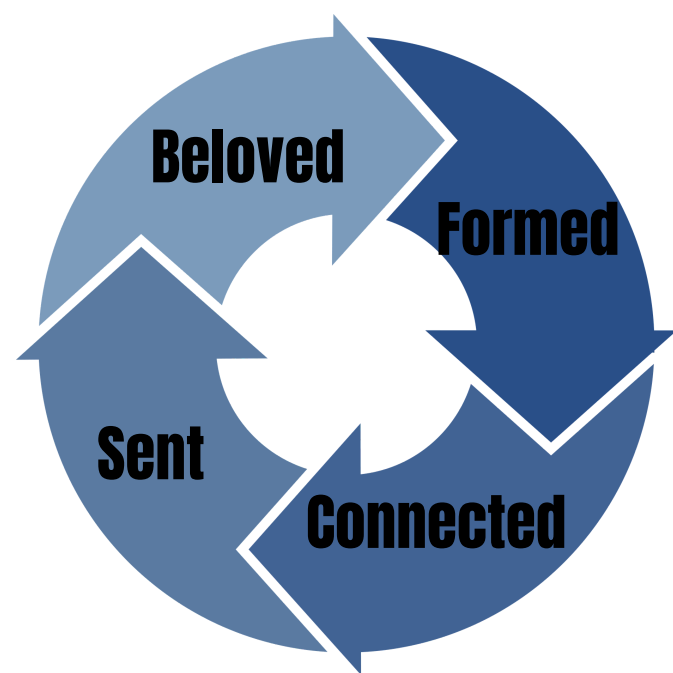


The Story We're Joining...

Beloved

Discovering who God says you are.

Students are shown they are beloved through...

- a foundational focus on God's grace in their lives
- regular acts of kindness and remembrance of what matters to them
- Student Encouragement Network volunteers

Formed

Learning to follow Jesus every day.

Students are formed through...

- digging into Scripture during Sunday Night Gatherings
- exploring the Christian faith at Confirmation
- Sunday School discussions
- exposure to regular rhythms of spiritual practices and special retreat opportunities
- opportunities to lead in both Student Ministry and in the life of the church

Connected

Growing together in Christian community.

Student Ministry Chats

IDENTITY STUDY (IN YOUTH WING, WED. @ 6PM)

What does the Lord's Prayer have to say about who we are? This small group study invites students to explore their God-given identity by walking them through the prayer Jesus taught his first disciples to pray. We'll get curious about what scripture means when it says we've all been adopted as heirs to God's kingdom.



CONFIRMATION (IN YOUTH WING, SUN. 9:45AM - 10:45AM)

A yearlong investigation of Christian faith and Methodist heritage, Confirmation creates a space filled with fun, connection, discernment, and learning. To prepare students to take next steps in their faith, confirmed members of Grace UMC will facilitate discussions on a variety of topics, such as:

*The Bible | John Wesley and Methodism | God's Grace | Worship
Salvation | Prayer | Sacraments of Baptism and Communion | Jesus*

Confirmation is available to our 6th Graders and others who wish to participate. Our Confirmation Sunday celebration is in May.

SUNDAY NIGHT GATHERING (IN YOUTH WING, 5:45PM - 7:30PM)

Our main weekly hangout, Sunday Night Gatherings are full of fun and learning together about what it means to live as beloved children of God who are being formed into disciples of Jesus. Building connections with one another prepares students to go out into the world to love and serve their neighbors, as partners in God's mission of redemption.

Caring for Students Well

Because we believe every student is God's beloved child, Grace Student Ministry is committed to providing an environment where young people can be formed in their faith, connected to authentic Christian community, and sent into the world to reflect the love of Christ. Our Safe Sanctuary Policy helps create the secure, healthy environment that allows this kind of discipleship to flourish. Highlights of our practices include:

REGULAR PROGRAMMING

- background checks and training for all volunteers
- 2 unrelated, trained adults at all times
- visible, open environments for all activities

TRIPS & RETREATS

- info about schedules, lodging, transportation, & expectations is shared early
- updated liability forms required
- overnight events include trained chaperones, emergency preparedness, and clear accountability procedures

PARTNERING WITH FAMILIES

We understand that each student is unique. We collaborate with parents/guardians to offer necessary accommodations for medical, developmental, or emotional needs, ensuring that every student can participate safely and with dignity.
