General Scholarship Application Preparation 2026

The Ravenell-Babb Youth Excellence Scholarship Foundation understands the importance and role education provides for youth who recognize the value of community service and education. The scholarship is intended to assist youth to pursue an education to influence and promote the long-held tradition of Bishop Ravenell and Reverend Dr. Babb in hopes that they too become leaders in their communities of tomorrow.

General Eligibility

- Be a high school senior in the Tri-County area (Berkeley, Charleston, Dorchester);
- Intend to pursue higher education leading to a certificate, associate's, or bachelor's degree;
- Earn a 2.0 GPA based on the SC Uniform Grading Policy (SCUGP);
- Submit a completed application packet deadline by: May 3, 2026.

Required Information

Be prepared to answer questions about the following:

- General Personal Information (i.e. contact information, etc.)
- High School Information and GPA
- College or Higher Education Institution (intended to enroll at)
- Personal Volunteer/Work History, if applicable
- Contact Information of two persons who will serve as your reference

Required Documents

- Two Letters of Recommendation (cannot be from a family member)
- Copy of high school transcript

Required Personal Letter

- Write a letter directed to the **Scholarship Review Committee** describing your short-term and long-term personal and education/career goals and what has helped to shape your goals. What specific steps will you take to reach your personal/education/career goals? Lastly, express how you would continue with the legacy of community leadership.

Required Essay Questions

Complete an essay in 200 words or more on one of the topics below:

1. Describe any challenges you faced, how have you overcome these challenges, and how has it affected your goals and personal character?
2. Describe how you plan to give back to your community after you have completed your education?
3. Thinking about your experiences (i.e. in the community, church, or employment), what would you like to teach the world?
