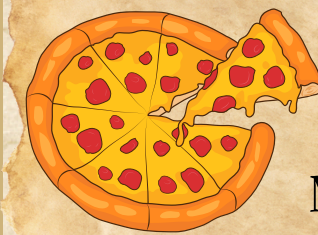

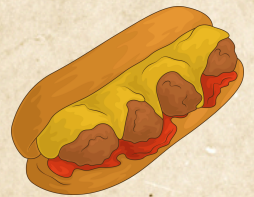

- Trade in quiet areas away from booths



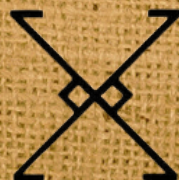
## ✗ DON'T:

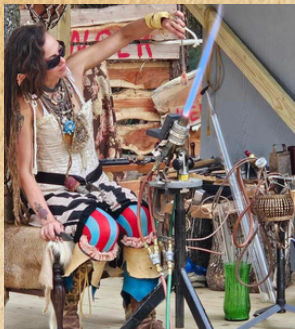
