A message from our pastor
Fr. Robert Ni Ni, MF

This Sunday's readings give us guidelines regarding how to treat others. As Christians, we are called to treat others with love. The first reading from the Book of Exodus focuses on how we treat the defenseless and marginalized: "You shall not oppress a foreigner. You shall not mistreat any widow or orphan." It is all too easy to take advantage of the vulnerable or the stranger, but that is not the Christian way. God demands something different from us.

In today's Gospel from St. Matthew, Jesus introduces a new teaching about how to treat others. He emphasizes the importance of loving both God and neighbor. While you may think that loving God is more important than loving your neighbor, Jesus says that both are alike. To love God means we also must love our neighbor. If we neglect the well-being of others, how can we claim that we love God?

Sometimes, it is a challenge to love others because of bitterness, resentment, or hurt. These are the times when our tenderness and compassion toward others is tested. During challenging times, we must actively demonstrate love, not just as a feeling, but as an action. Love means we put others' needs before our own. We take action to benefit others.

The opposite of love is opportunism – exploiting others for our own gain. Opportunists take advantage of the suffering and misfortunes of others to get ahead themselves. That is one of the concerns we had in rebuilding Lahaina. Will opportunists victimize landowners with a land grab or charge high interest rates on loans to rebuild?

This is a challenging time for Lahaina. What will move the city forward is love, not opportunistic behavior.

This week, think of a way you can love someone who is a widow, orphan, or stranger, or consider how you can love someone who has caused you pain. By doing so, you show your love for God, also.




WE ARE NOW ACCEPTING NEW REGISTRATIONS FOR CHILDREN 3 YEARS OF AGE AND OLDER.
