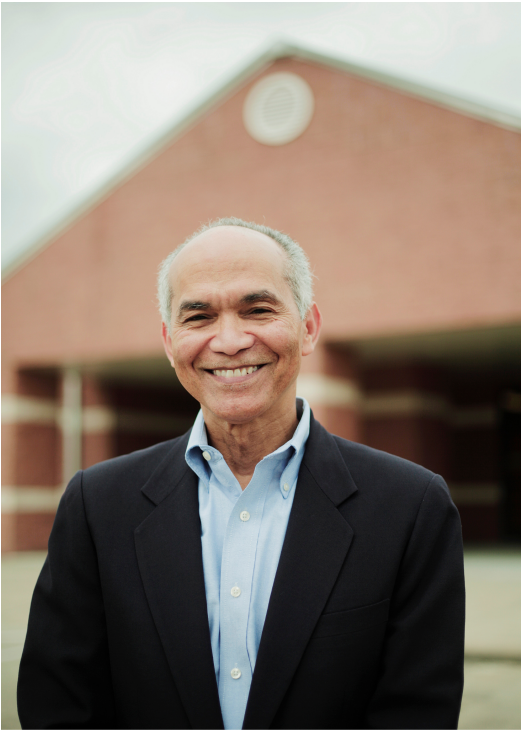

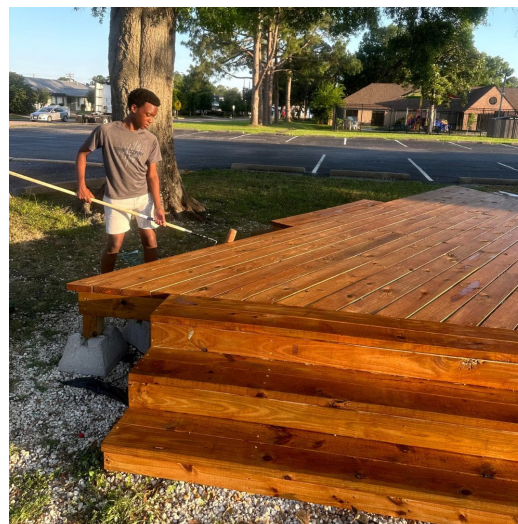
April Highlights

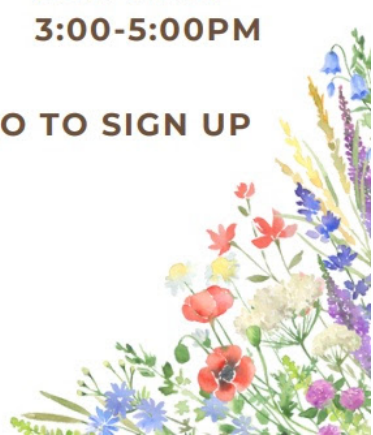
