


Bible Story - Jesus' Death, Burial and Resurrection

God is always faithful to finish the good work He starts in our lives. It's easy for us to lose faith in that process, though. When things seem to be going wrong, we think God has quit on us. We think He has left us all alone.

The disciples probably felt that way after Jesus died on the cross. They thought He was gone...but Jesus rose from the dead on Easter Sunday to prove that what God starts, He always FINISHES!



Kids are invited to join the C.S.I. Team to investigate if Jesus rose from the dead.
They'll examine three scenes to look for clues, collect evidence and talk with eyewitnesses. The evidence will lead them to make a decision about whether Jesus' resurrection is true and if they want to enter a relationship with Him.

This lesson is also a great way to teach kids apologetics for the resurrection. It takes kids on a

deeper dive to help them understand how they can know Jesus rose from the dead.
