This coming Friday is Groundhog Day, but is known in the Church as the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord, forty days after Christmas and the day He was presented in the Temple by Mary and Joseph, in fulfilment of the Law (the Torah), because of the recognition of how God had saved the firstborn of the Hebrews in Egypt during the tenth and last plague. The offering made by Mary and Joseph was two turtledoves, the one which the poor made. They were met by the two holy old people, Anna and Simeon, and so the day is known among Eastern Christians as “Hypapante,” the Feast of the Meeting. Candles for home use that you may bring will be blessed at Mass that morning, along with some that are used at the altar, and we will have our usual monthly Eucharistic exposition and devotion for an hour after Mass. There should be a table in the sanctuary for you to place your candles. Jesus is truly the light of the world and that was revealed at the Presentation.

Saturday morning (with First Saturday devotions following) is the memorial of St. Blaise and throats will be blessed at Mass.
