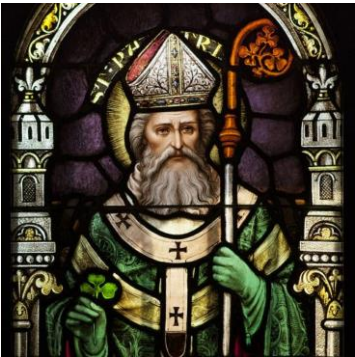

In any event, he always pointed to the Lord and we must do the same.
