Pastor’s Notes:

Today is the traditional feast day of St. Brigid of Ireland, although it is no longer on the universal Roman liturgical calendar and would not be celebrated today in any event (since it is the Lord’s Day), so I just want to offer a nod to this great woman who was one of the early saints of “the island of saints and scholars.” The St. Bridget on the calendar (July 23) was a holy woman of Sweden who took the name of the Irish one. Saints be praised!

Monday is the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord, forty days after Christmas, and it is popularly called “Candlemas,” since at the Mass that day the candles that will be used in the liturgy for the coming year are blessed (and also any candles you may wish blessed for use in the home, especially for religious purposes—you may place such candles on the west back table by the main church door before morning Mass). I recently learned that it is good to have a candle in your vehicle’s emergency kit in case you are stranded in the cold—the heat from one candle may be enough to save you from freezing to death. Jesus, of course, is the real Light of the World, and on that day we recall His entry into the Temple with Mary and Joseph as a forty-day-old baby who delighted the two holy older people, Anna and Simeon, who had been waiting for this moment their whole lives. The custom at the time was to “present” the oldest son in the family to God with an offering to thank Him for saving the oldest son from the Angel of Death during the Tenth Plague in Egypt. As the blood of the lamb was sprinkled on the doorpost to signal that this was a place to be spared, so the Angel would “pass over,” Jesus’s Precious Blood would be “sprinkled” on the people of the world from the Cross as a sign of our redemption. The “two turtledoves” that Mary and Joseph offered was the offering specified in the law of Moses (the Torah or Pentateuch, the first five books of the Bible) to be given by the poor. May Christ’s light shine in every heart! We are also halfway through winter, as the groundhog custom reminds us.

The day after this feast, Tuesday, is also the optional memorial of St. Blaise, and the custom is to bless throats and ask for assistance. I will plan to bless throats next weekend after Mass as well for those who would like. Tuesday is also the optional memorial of St. Ansgar, apostle to Scandinavia.
