We are happy to announce that we received our yearly "kickback" from the diocesan Religious Education Endowment—set up by the last diocesan campaign. It was for \$472.48. Thanks also to our CCD director, Miranda Teel, who arranged for us to receive an additional \$930, which will be used to offset the cost of our Totus Tuus program in the summer (June 2026). Thanks to the many parishioners who made this possible many years ago!

Speaking of diocesan programs, we again have the opportunity of supporting many worthy projects which are beyond the resources at the parish level, and we do this through the Charity and Stewardship Appeal, originally known as DDP (the Diocesan Development Program). This has been a source of blessings to each and every parish of the diocese over the years (low-interest loans for capital projects), as well as the support of many worthy causes—strengthening young adults in their faith, supporting ministries to bring Christ's mercy to families, the vulnerable, and those on the margins, among others. The diocesan goal is \$2,002,480, and our parish goal is \$6840. All money raised over that amount here comes back to the parish (and that has been the case the last few years at least). Your printed pledge cards are in envelopes in the back of the church. You may use the envelopes to return to the parish, but if you include a check, please make it to the "Catholic Bishop of Lincoln" or "CSA" or "DDP" rather than to St. Catherine's. Thank you in advance for your generosity!
