Pastor’s Notes:

Today, weather permitting, we will be going to four stations outside with the Blessed Sacrament after Mass. We want to bring Jesus to the whole world. On this day we remember the gift of His own Body and Blood that our Savior gave us on Holy Thursday, so that we could perpetually remember the gift of Himself on the Cross on Good Friday. Although He is ascended to the Father, He is still here with us—He told us He would not leave us orphans and that that He would be with us always, even until the end of the world. And He is really present in the tabernacle at all times, so that we will not forget.

Friday is the last of the great “movable” feasts that are based on the movable date of Easter. It is the Solemnity of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. Just as Corpus Christi reminds us of Holy Thursday and gives us a chance to meditate on what it means, so the Sacred Heart day is a chance to reflect on the meaning of Good Friday. In response to the request of then-Pepe John Paul II (now St. John Paul II), it is a day of prayer for priests, along with our other prayers. We will have a simple exposition of the Eucharist beginning at 6:30 A.M. I will lead the Litany of the Sacred Heart at about 6:55, and the Rosary will be recited as usual, with simple reposition before Mass begins at 7:30. Our daily Mass people should appreciate this, but anyone is welcome for some or all—stop by on the way to work for a minute or two? The Lord is always happy to see you in His house. May the Heart of Jesus, in the Most Blessed Sacrament, be praised, adored, and loved, with grateful affection, at every moment, in all the tabernacles of the world, even to the end of time. Amen.

Friday we are expecting the six seminarians with Fr. Jim Morin, the new seminary rector, who are making their pilgrimage across the diocese (from Nebraska City to Benkelman) by foot. They will be staying the rectory overnight. Thanks to all who are helping with arrangements. Welcome!

We will also be having the St. Catherine Altar Society Guest Day in the hall on Saturday morning. A busy week indeed!

Thanks to all who gave to the diocesan Charity and Stewardship Appeal (DDP). We have (so far) over \$11,000 in donations and pledges, far above our \$6840 parish goal. Not only are we helping some great diocesan programs (which we could not organize on a parish level), but everything above our goal comes back to us—this should be a great way to offset the cost of fixing the cracks in our parking lot—a project that cost over \$6000.
