The Diocesan Niobrara Canoe Trips down the Niobrara River began in 1995 under the direction of Fr. Ronald Homes. The canoe trips are open to high school youth (sophomores, juniors, seniors) and college students. Adults are also invited along as sponsors/drivers. Fr. Homes continues to direct the Canoe Trips with the assistance of the Youth Ministry Office. Nearly 200 participants from all over the Diocese partake in one of two different canoe trips. Pastor’s Notes:

Today we remember the gift of Jesus to us for all the time until He comes again at the end of the world. It is the Holy Eucharist, so beautifully explained in chapter 6 of St. John’s Gospel. Our procession today outside (weather permitting) is a sign that we want to bring Him to all four corners of the world. Thanks to those who set up altars, decorated them, brought flower petals, and most of all, thanks to all who took part in this show of love to Jesus Christ, Risen Lord and King of Kings. This coming Friday is the Solemnity of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, and in accord with the request of then-Pope John Paul II (now a canonized saint!), we will have a special Eucharistic day to pray for priests, along with our other prayers. I will have a simple exposition of the Eucharist beginning at 6:30 A.M. I will lead the Litany of the Sacred Heart at about 6:55, and the Rosary will be recited as usual, with simple reposition before Mass begins at 7:30. You are invited to stop in during the hour—or at any convenient hour during the day—or any day, even if there is no exposition. The Lord is always happy to see you in His house.

Since the First Friday of July falls on Independence Day, and we plan to have Mass that day at 9 A.M. so that more can come and pray in thanksgiving and petition for our dear country, we will have exposition and reposition in a manner similar to the week before (as described above), from 8 until 9, with the Litany of the Sacred Heart at 8:25 and recitation of the Rosary following (as usual for daily Mass). Take any opportunity you can to “waste” time with the Lord of all times and seasons.

We are happy to be doing a baptism this weekend and another next weekend—these are the first baptisms since Easter—of last year! We are happy to have another “baby boom” as we had about ten years ago. New little ones are always welcome!

Thanks to Doug Cure for organizing a training morning for new servers. Unfortunately, there were none that could come. Maybe we will try again. We are always happy to have new altar servers—a wonderful act of stewardship from some of our young men.

By my calculations, we have \$17,280 pledged to DDP this year, well over our parish goal of \$6480. In addition to helping with several wonderful apostolates on the diocesan level that we could not sustain on a parish level, everything over the goal is supposed to come back to us. It will be welcome especially as we hope to do our outside painting project this summer. God bless all of our generous parishioners and all those who are good stewards of the time, talent, and treasure entrusted to them by God.
