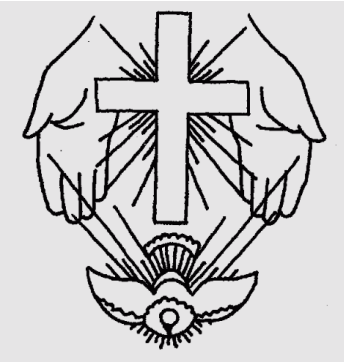

Pastor's Notes:

Parish council is scheduled to meet this evening in the rectory dining room at 6 P.M. We have not met for three months. No major crises, we hope, but we will continue to look at long-term needs, such as the old part of the parish hall and the area north of the hall. If you have any concerns, let one of us know.

It has also been some time since the centennial committee met (since March 1), but the representatives of the Altar Society, the Knights, and the parish council have been very helpful in pointing all of us in the right direction. As of now, we have received an acknowledgment of our invitation to the Bishop, and he is planning on celebrating a Mass on Sunday, October 17, 2027, at 11 A.M. (this will probably replace the 9 A.M. Mass that day) and we will have a catered meal in the hall especially for parishioners (but we will need a count), but also for former parishioners and other friends if space permits. Some of the Jim and Ida Dolan descendants may join us as well as we remember 100 years in our beautiful church dedicated to St. Catherine of Alexandria (the patron saint of Jim's mother). Before that, our earlier parish church was dedicated to the Sacred Heart of Jesus, and the original name of our Catholic community was St. Virgilius—an unusual patron—the early bishop of Salzburg in Austria, but from Ireland, so perhaps chosen to recognize the early settlers from German-speaking areas and Ireland?

Thanks to Doug Cure, one of our new acolytes, for his help in training our new servers. Thanks to all who helped in any way with our pilgrimage seminarians, especially Crinda McConville and Roger Buschkoetter. Thanks to the many more who offered help—we did not know the plan for meals, etc., until almost the last minute. If Fr. Jim Morin (the new rector) ever decides to do it again, we have an idea of how it will go and maybe we can have something with all the parishioners that would like to meet them. As it was, we had them during a very busy week here.

On Friday, June 12, which was the day of the Solemnity of the Sacred Heart of Jesus this year, we who were at Eucharistic adoration before daily Mass consecrated our parish, along with Bishop Conley, who was consecrating the whole of our Diocese of Lincoln, and the Bishops of the United States, who were consecrating our nation to the Lord, the Sacred Heart. A beautiful gift for our beautiful country as we celebrate 250 years of independence. Saturday morning Mass will be at 9 A.M. so we can pray for our country on its birthday.
