We are privileged to celebrate two of the "princes" of the early Church, Peter and Paul. Because their celebration is a "solemnity," we observe it even on the Lord's Day, the day always dedicated to their King, Christ the King. The Gospel of John ends with the prediction by the risen Lord about what kind of death Peter would undergo-by tradition, he was crucified upside-down in Rome and buried on the site where St. Peter's Church now stands-the high altar is directly over his grave, according to the best archaeology that affirms that tradition. Paul, whose story comes to a close in Rome at the end of the Acts of the Apostles, was, by tradition, beheaded on the site of St. Paul's-Outside-the Walls Church-he was allowed the more merciful execution since he was not a subject or slave of Rome, but a citizen. These two martyrs ("witnesses") were the Apostles who founded the Church of Rome, whose bishop, the successor of St. Peter, continues to be the visible sign of unity on earth for the Church. This year, the unthinkable happened when we were blessed with the election of the first American-born pope, Pope Leo XIV, who, because of his missionary work in South America, is also a citizen of Peru as well as of the United States. The "Peter's Pence" collection goes back at least as far as King Alfred the Great in England some 1200 years ago, and is our privileged way of showing our communion with the Church of Rome and its bishop, our Holy Father. The money is used by him for his administration and other needs, and our gift is a sign of our love. Viva il Papa! Long live the Pope!

Friday is the day on which we have a holiday in our country in honor of our independence in 1776. It has been 249 years in which the great "American experiment" has been conducted, and, despite the polarization in our politics of late, we continue to be a beacon of hope and light to the rest of the world. The American dream is still very much alive. You are invited to pray for our nation, its people and its leaders, at Mass on Friday at 9 A.M. (no 7:30 A.M. Mass that day) and, since it is the First Friday of July, we will have the Eucharist exposed from 8 to 9, and we will have our Litany of the Sacred Heart at 8:25 and the Rosary (as usual) at 8:30. Come to the real "King" of our nation and thank Him for our many blessings and pray for our many needs.

Pope's Intention for July: For formation in discernment. Let us pray that we may again learn how to discern, to know how to choose paths of life and reject everything that leads us away from Christ and the Gospel.
