Pastor's Notes:

We are planning to have our regular parish council meeting (last Sunday of the month) next Sunday at 6 P.M. in the rectory dining room. We have paid Kucera Painting for the work done (\$60,000) which was something the council had been attempting to accomplish over the last couple of years. It should enhance and preserve our windows from water damage (on the rare occasions when we get rain!). We were able to pay out of the parish checking account with only \$30,000 from our "nest egg" in the Catholic Foundation, due to the generosity of the Knights of Columbus, the St. Catherine Altar Society, and many families which made a special contribution for the project. There are always ongoing maintenance challenges in facilities like ours, but we will continue to try to stay ahead of the curve. My sense from previous discussions is that the next big project may be dealing with the old hall. We shall see! Thanks to all who have contributed money and/or prayers for us! Thanks also to the council members who negotiated a \$7000 reduction in our bill to Kucera, due to the fact that our lift was indeed able to reach to the bell tower and we did not need a bigger lift from Kearney. Wonderful!

I am also happy to report the repair and return of an old ciborium (the container for the Holy Eucharist) which was tarnished and broken. We can thank the memorial from Beverly Haag to cover the cost for the work done at Koley's in Omaha. I do not know when the ciborium was last in regular use, but we can certainly use it for the special times we need an extra one here.

The date of the dedication of our current church building was October 13, 1927—this being about the third regular building for the parish, and it was dedicated with the name of St. Catherine of Alexandria, the patron saint of the mother of one of our principal benefactors, James Dolan—the earlier names of our parish were St. Virgilius (1883) and Sacred Heart (1906). The Dolan home (about 1.5 miles west of town) provided the location of the first Mass on July 21, 1880, and it was here that Bishop O'Connor made his first visit on May 19, 1881, when he confirmed sixteen individuals. The first church (across the street from the southeast corner of the park) was built on land donated by the Dolans, measuring 28' by 40' and dedicated on December 1, 1883 at a cost of \$1300, and since this was inadequate for the sixty families then comprising the parish, an addition was made in the 1890s measuring 18' by 28', at a cost of \$1260. If you count the Dolan home, our current church is the third for the parish, but if you count the actual church buildings, it is the second. In 1919, six acres were purchased from Joseph and Mary Junker for \$3250 as the site of what would become our current location. God bless!
