Saturday is a holy day, but there is no Mass obligation this year. It is the Solemnity of All Saints, and it reminds us that those in heaven with God are a group which consists not only of the angels and canonized saints (those who are publicly recognized), but also those who are not known, but who live in glory. There are many people we have known who, we suspect, are in that number, and it will all be revealed to us at the Last Judgment on the Last Day. Sunday we celebrate All Souls' Day as we remember our duty to pray for those who have gone before us, especially members of our own family. All these will see God in heaven when God has finished purifying them and making them worthy of heaven.
