Pastor's Notes:

There will be three Masses to celebrate the Nativity of the Lord and to help us fulfill our holy day obligation—at 5 P.M. and 10 P.M. on Wednesday, December 24 (Christmas Eve) and at 9 A.M. on Thursday, December 25 (Christmas Day). The first two will use the readings from the "Mass during the Night" and the third will use the readings from the "Mass at Dawn." We are most blest to have so many organists and singers to cover any important Masses that we have. The Word became Flesh and made His dwelling among us. In a dark and dangerous place and time, the Light came into the world. We do not have to be afraid.

Please note that Fr. Wehrs will join me for confessions at 4 P.M. today (Sunday). He will be in the east sacristy (to the right of the altar) and I will be in the old west sacristy, which is now the usual confessional. Both places have the option of "face to face" if you so request or choose. There are also helpful Examinations of Conscience on the front pillar of the west side of church and other aids available on the table in the back. We will both be at Cambridge at 3 P.M., and there should be at least five priests in McCook at 7 P.M. Although there are other times (1-2 P,M, and 7-8 P.M. on Tuesday and 11 A.M.-12 Noon on Wednesday), these times may work the best for many of you. If it has been a while, that is okay. Jesus did not come for the righteous, but for sinners, of which I (at least) am one. God is good!

Next Saturday, we will have a special Mass in honor of the Holy Innocents at 10 A.M. This Mass will remember the "little ones" that have gone before us, even those who became adults, whose parents and families grieve their loss. Although the day we usually commemorate the little ones of Bethlehem that were killed by Herod's soldiers in his rage to destroy a potential rival to his power is December 28, which is Sunday this year and will be "trumped" by the Lord's Day celebration of the Holy Family, we will use Holy Innocents as our "votive Mass." December 27 is also the feast of St. John the Apostle, but we will be using the Holy Innocents Mass. All are welcome and there will be refreshments in the hall afterwards (as opposed to the full meal we had last year), so people will have a chance to visit with each other and then be on their way. For your information, that Saturday is also the 10th anniversary of Msgr. Pohl's death and the 29th anniversary of Msgr. Wageman's death. Tuesday is the 43rd anniversary of Msgr. Barnes's death. Remember!
