

## Maths

### Multiplication and Division

- Count in 2s, 5s and 10s.
- Make and add equal groups.
- Make arrays.
- Use grouping and sharing methods.
- Recognise and recall doubles.

### Fractions

- Find half of a quantity.
- Find a quarter of a quantity.

## PSHE - Managing Safety and Risks

Children will:

- Be able to name a familiar risky situation and suggest ways of reducing risk.
- Be able to explain a simple strategy for action if they are lost.
- Be able to recognise dangers that traffic poses.
- Know ways to stay safer in the sun.
- Describe ways of preventing accidents on the playground.
- Understand what is meant by an emergency and who might help them.

## Music - What can you hear?

Children will use voices and untuned percussion instruments to compose a piece of music which tells the story of the family walk in 'We're going on a bear hunt'. They will explore Russian composer Rimsky Korsakov's 'The Flight of the Bumblebee'.

## Computing - Creating Media - Digital Writing

Children will learn:

- To recognise the keys on a computer keyboard.
- How to use word processor to create digital text.

## Digital Citizenship - digital footprint and identity

Children will:

- Understand that anything we say or do online leaves a digital footprint.
- Know not to share personal information online.

# Adventurers Summer 1

## RE - What is my view of the world?

Children will be introduced to the idea that 'no-one stands nowhere'. We will explore the ways in which context affects our ways of seeing and understanding the world, each other and ourselves. Using what they have learned, children will explore their own worldviews.

## Science - Plants

Children will:

- Know what plants need in order to grow.
- Name and describe the parts of a plant.
- Understand that some trees are evergreen, and some are deciduous.
- Recognise the parts of the plant we eat.

## English - The Jungle Book' by Rudyard Kipling.

- Children will:
- Identify and write simple sentences
  - Begin to write compound sentences joined with 'and' and 'but'.
  - Maintain a consistent tense.
  - Identify and write questions.
  - Use capital letters, full stops and question marks.
  - Use apostrophes for contractions and possession.

## Geography - The seven continents

Children will:

- Name the 7 continents and 5 oceans.
- Identify the poles and the equator.
- Describe the continents.
- Recognise Europe as one of the world's seven continents.

## Art - Paintings of Children

Children will:

- Explore Hogarth's painting 'The Graham Children'.
- Using line to plan a painting.
- Match colour and using different brushes.
- Creating a picture based on 'The Graham Children'.

### Games

Children will:

- Develop fundamental skills through games.
- Know to score and play by the rules.
- Know to work with a partner.
- Understand what a team is.
- Learn through winning and losing.

### Yoga

- Develop balance, flexibility, strength and mindfulness.
