Be a Word Whizz!

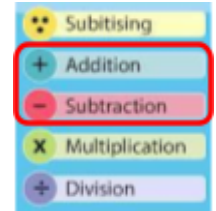
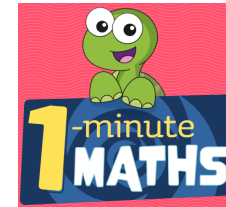

South Pole	A very cold place at the ' bottom ' of the Earth.
Equator	An imaginary line around the middle of the Earth.
