Understanding the World

- Children will learn that there are many different types of transport and will think about how we can travel safely.
- They will find out about different types of land and water transport around the world.
 - They will learn that transport in the past was different from the present day.
- Through learning about Ernest Shackleton children will find out about travelling in cold places.

Expressive Arts and Design Art

- Children to study Turner's seascapes with boats on. Children to use collage to create their own seascape.
 - Can the children invent their own vehicle? We will be making cars using junk modelling.

Music

- Through role play they will use imaginative movement and vocabulary to recreate scenes from familiar stories.
- Opportunities will be provided for emergent writing (with ongoing provision for mark making).
- We will focus on letter formation following our handwriting policy.
- In line with Sounds Write, we will continue to focus on our sounds and reading and writing simple words and phrases.

Communication and Language

- Children will join in with repeated refrains and familiar stories.
- They will follow directions, recognising left and right and show an understanding of prepositions such as 'under, on top'.
- Children will use vocabulary, including phrases, from recently read stories in conversations.
- They will ask questions using what, where, when and why to find out information.

Physical Education

- In PE lessons and whilst enjoying the outside areas, we will be working on spatial awareness and coordination games. Children will be dancing to music, moving with control around the floor.
- We will be developing pencil control by working on hand strength and fine motor skills, encouraging the use of small tools and playdough.
