an **instrument** where the sound is made by **blowing into it**

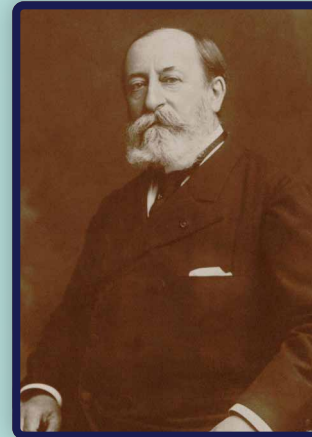
a **percussion instrument** that makes a **certain pitch** when it is **hit**
