Be a regular reader

Year 1: Please also focus on being able to spell the number words for zero to twenty.

Year 2: Please also focus on being able to spell the number words for zero to one-hundred

Be a mathematician!

Year 2's let's practice our O and I times tables! Remember to learn up to multiplications of 12.

You can practice these however you would like! You may wish to write these

down for example; $1 \times 2 = 2$. Or you may wish to write yourself some

questions and then answer them. If you do this you will be practising number formation too.

Read, learn and define our key vocabulary for this half-term's learning. You can find all the key vocabulary on our knowledge organisers for this half-term.



Create your own picture using the primary colours (red, yellow and blue) in the style of Piet Mondrian.







Draw a picture of your favourite part in your favourite fairy tale. Write a sentence to explain your picture.






Be a creator
