Maths

We will be learning to recognise numbers I-IO as well as exploring different ways to represent numbers. This allows the children time to develop a deeper understanding of number and place value. To support this, we will be using a range of equipment and resources to develop independence and confidence with mathematical tasks.

Understanding the World

We will be learning lots about Earth and the different countries, cultures, and people within it

We will be looking at our local area and how villages and town vary.

We will be looking at a range of different occupations this half term. If you'd like to share what your job entails with the class via Zoom or in person, please let us know.

Expressive Arts and Design

We will be using a range of resources to create representations of ourselves. We will be looking at the seasons and using natural resources to create collages.

Writing

We will be developing pencil control by working on a range fine motor activities.

We will be looking closely at how to form letters correctly.

We will be learning to apply our growing phonics knowledge to writing simple CVC words.

Religious Education

Our Christian value this half term is Friendship.

Our focus in RE will be learning about how we are all unique and different amongst our neighbours in school, the local community and in the world. We will begin to understand what a family is and explore different types of families and learn about what is meant by community.

Reading

Physical Education

Communication and Language

We will be developing listening and attention skills as this is key to communicating effectively. There will be a wide range of activities and experiences that will encourage children to get to know each other as well as the adults in the class.
