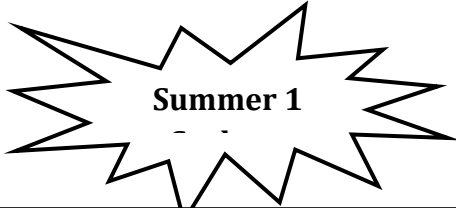


Visit

Music
This half term, we will be exploring sound through various composers and instruments.

Maths

Year 3:
Count in fractions.
Add, subtract, order and compare fractions.
Find fractions of amounts.
Understand tenths.
Measure, compare, add and subtract mass and capacity.
Count money.
Convert pounds and pence.

Year 4:
Count, add and subtract fractions.
Find fractions of quantities.
Understand tenths and hundredths.
Divide 1 & 2-digit numbers by 10 and 100.
Compare, order and round decimal numbers.
Order, estimate, add and subtract money.

There will be a focus on gaining mastery of the 12 times table.

HALF TERM VALUE - Generosity
This half-term we will learn about, and use generosity across the curriculum.

Latin: This half term, there will be a focus on object and subject nouns. Pupils will learn to identify and use these in sentences.

Computing: This half term, Seekers will be Data logging where they will collect and analyse data. They will also explore the concept of repetition in programming to create a game.

PE
In PE this term, there is a focus on Outdoor Adventurous Activities. Pupils will develop problem solving skills through a range of challenges. Pupils will work in small groups to plan, solve and reflect to improve of their strategies. They will also learn to orientate a map, identify ley symbols and follow routes.

PSHE
This half term, Seekers will be learning about managing safety and risk. They will be considering how to react to accidents, emergencies, potential hazards relating to roads and water.

This unit builds on children's understanding of The Stuarts.

Science - States of matter
