

Maths

Year 3

Measure, compare, add and subtract mass and capacity.
Count, convert add and subtract money using pounds and pence.
Recognise hours, months and years.
Tell the time to the nearest minute.
Compare and measure durations of time.
Interpret pictograms and bar charts.
Recognise turns and angles.
Recognise parallel and perpendicular lines.

Year 4

Write, compare, order and round decimal numbers.
Order, estimate and compare money using pounds and pence.
Recognise lines of symmetry.
Convert hours, minutes, seconds, years, months, weeks and days.
Understand analogue and digital clocks using 12 and 24 hour.
Interpret charts and graphs.
Identify, compare and order angles.
Identify the properties of triangles and quadrilaterals.

Digital Citizenship: This half term, pupils will look at the question: Is seeing believing? Seekers will recognise that photos can be altered digitally and discuss why these photos or videos are edited.

English

Reading: Class book – **The Miraculous Journey of Edward Tulane**

Fiction: The children will be writing a fable version of the Edward Tulane story.

Pupils will also be writing an introduction to a play script for Shakespeare's book: Julius Caesar.

Punctuation, Grammar and Spelling:

Grammar: Complex sentences, adverbials, present participles

Punctuation: Commas, apostrophes, inverted commas

Spellings: High frequency words and year 4 spellings.

HALF TERM VALUE - Trust

This half-term we will learn about Trust and the impact this has within our lives.

PSHE

This half term, Seekers will be learning about healthy lifestyles. We will be identifying some of the ways we can look after ourselves.

Computing: This half term, we will be exploring the concept of repetition in programming using Scratch. Pupils will learn about the difference between count-controlled and infinite loops and use their knowledge to modify existing animations and games using repetition.

Music

This half term, we will be using percussion instruments to compose our own fanfare

Latin: This half term, the Seekers are re-capping Latin grammar and using imperative verbs and object nouns in sentences.

Visit

This half term, we will be visiting Wells beach.

PE

In PE this term, there is a focus on cricket. Pupils will develop control using a bat. They will understand the role of fielding and awareness of space.

Science - Electricity

Pupils will learn about electricity. They will learn that common appliances run on electricity and will make simple circuits. Pupils will study the different components within a circuit and will consider what will happen when a circuit is broken. They will learn about the inventor Thomas Edison and his work.

Art - Needlework, Embroidery and Weaving

Pupils will be develop their technique through the study of the embroidery on the coronation dress of Elizabeth II and the Duchess of Cambridge's wedding dress. Pupils will learn different stitches to design and create their own book mark.
