Communication and Language

Play listening games such as 'Simon Says'. Read a favourite book, talk about and retell the story. Encourage your child to share our weekly Nursery Rhyme.

English

Notice familiar signs and logos and see if your child can read them. Notice that print has meaning. Read the story of 'The Three Little Pigs' encouraging your child to join in with the refrains. Build your own den! Practise writing/mark making using a stick in the mud or your finger in some rice or sand.

Physical Development

Practice the tricky task of putting on your coat and zipping it up.

Make a flag or streamers and wave it in the air using big body movements.

Draw a track using chalk and follow it using your bike or scooter.


Vocabulary
